Metro Rail pillars to be built alongside colony, church

By Our Staff Reporter

A portion of the compound wall of Krupa Colony on 1st Avenue, Ashok Nagar was demolished last week to facilitate the work of installing pillars for the Chennai Metro Rail Project.

The corridor will pass alongside the colony.

An engineer of the company which has been given the contract to construct the stretch from Koyambedu to 1st Avenue-4th Avenue junction, told *Mambalam Times* that two pillars will be installed outside Krupa Colony and another outside the church adjacent to the colony.

He said that after the pillars are installed, the compound wall of Krupa Colony will be rebuilt.

Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) has taken over the Corporation park at the of 4th Avenue-1st Avenue junction. A station will be built in the park, according to the engineer.

Since the Metro Rail corridor takes a turn towards Udham Theater before heading further down 100 Feet Road, sufficient turning radius is required at Ashok Pillar junction. To provide for this, the alignment will move from the median towards one end of the road before it approaches the junction.

The pillars of the elevated corridor will therefore come up on the edge of the park.

CMRL has taken over 4 parks in the city for the dura-



tion of the project after which necessary plans for the purpose.

A restoration committee, The entire Metro network is which will include representatives of NGOs, will draw up December 2015.

14-year-old boy drowned in swimming pool

According to police, there were many persons in the pool at the time but no one apparently noticed Satish struggling.

Sathish's father M. Kumar (49), an accountant in the Anna Salai branch of State Bank of India, had dropped his son at 7.30 a.m for swimming classes held from 7.40 a.m to 8.40 a.m. Satish had been attending the classes regularly.

When his father Kumar returned to pick him up at 9 a.m, Satish pleaded that he wanted to practise the lessons that he had learnt that day and went back to the pool.

Kumar waited outside for Satish. When he did not return

even after a very long time he rushed to the pool and found his son lying unconscious. He was rushed to hospital but was declared dead.

Police said that the coach had left the pool after the stipulated time was over.

Staff at the pool told police that there were too many persons in the water and it was difficult to monitor the movement of every swimmer.

One stretch of Rangarajapuram flyover almost ready

Though M. Subramanian (Mayor) had announced in August last year that work on the Rangarajapuram flyover would be over by October the same year, the work has still not been completed.

The Y-shaped flyover will connect Bazullah Road in T. Nagar with Subramaniapuram and Aziz Nagar in Kodambakkam.

The project is being jointly executed by Southern Railway (Rs. 8 crores) and Chennai Corporation (Rs. 15.75 crores). Work began three years ago.

Once commissioned, vehicles coming along Bazullah Road and bound for Kodambakkam will take a left turn at Vivek's junction and proceed on the flyover.

In the opposite direction, vehicles will use the two arms of the flyover - one starting from Rangarajapuram and the other from Railway Border Road - to reach North Usman Road.

A supervisor of the contractor told *Mambalam Times* on May 18 that the railways had completed the stretch on one arm of the flyover above the tracks and a portion of the flyover on the other arm of the flyover.

Work on the stretch of the flyover from Rangarajapuram to Bazullah Road, which includes one of the arms, is almost complete.

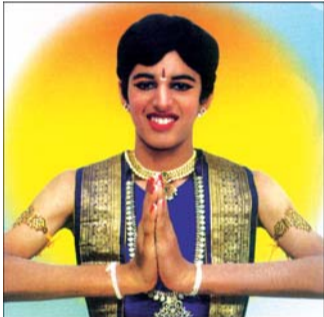
Mambalam Times that kumbhabheeshekam will be performed in November this year. Construction has almost been completed, he added. He said that the temple has been constructed on a 4200-

She said that oratorical, essay writing and Tamil poetry competitions are conducted for students on the 3rd Saturday of every month in association with 'Vasagar Vattam'.

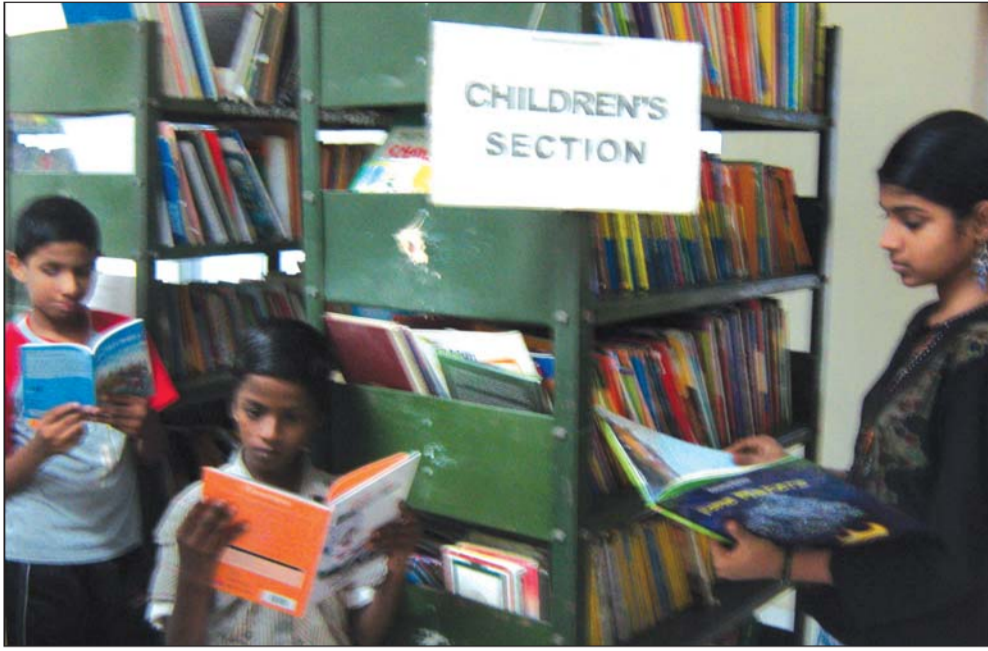
Janaki said that there are 53,000 books in the library covering a vast range of topics. More than 250 persons visit the library and members borrow about 250 books daily.
