The first phase of oral polio vaccine for 2017 will be administered to children below 5 years on Sunday, April. 2, under the Pulse polio immunization program.

The second phase will be administered on April 30.

Children under 5 should be immunized irrespective of their previous immunization status. Sick children, including those affected by diarrhea, can also be administered the polio drops.

She sells sugarcane juice in Arya Gowda Road

Sundari Mohan started Sakthi Vinayagar Juice Stall (Arya Gowda Road, West Mambalam) in 2001. She sells only sugarcane juice in the stall, which is popular in the neighbourhood. She uses a sugarcane crushing machine that runs on electricity to extract the juice.

Sundari told Mambalam Times that she mostly sources the sugarcane from Andhra Pradesh as it is of better taste and locally whenever there is shortage in supply.

She said that the electric crusher is more hygienic than the one that runs on fuel as it is devoid of the oil smell and grease that accumulates in the long run.

She charges Rs. 30 for 300 ml. and Rs. 40 for 400 ml.



She said that all her family members support her in running the juice stall during the peak summer season when demand is high. Last year, Sundari received the 'Women

Business Owner of Year' award from Bharthiya Mahlia Bank, Chennai. Her juice stall is open on all days from 9 a.m to 8 p.m. Her contact number is 97108 55245.

Special precautions for elders during summer

The following are her health tips for elders during summer:

1. Increase fluid intake and also watch out for overloading of kidneys (1.5 to 2 liters is important).
2. When down with any infection, take more fluids and also monitor sugar and BP levels.
3. Avoid getting dehydrated as it can cause metabolic disturbance, constipation and lead to breathing difficulty.
4. Avoid stepping out in the sun and, if necessary, carry enough water to drink.
5. Don't self medicate for

symptoms like muscle cramps, gasping, lack of sleep. Better see a doctor.

6. People on diuretics medication and diabetics should take extra care.

7. Avoid over exertion if you feel dehydrated.

No age limit to write NEET exam

During a recent general body meeting, Medical Council of India has passed a resolution removing the limit on the number of attempts for a candidate in the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET) and the age at which he/she can appear. On March 16, based on recommendations of the oversight committee and the Union Health Ministry, the MCI said both the limitations have been removed. MCI is also planning to relax rules that mandate a person to be 17 years to join the course.

TAMIL CINEMA 75 - A LOOK BACK

TAMIL CINEMA AND MUSIC 47

Madras Lalithangi Vasanthakumari was born in 1928 into a musical family. Her mother Lalithangi was a noted musician of her day and her father Ayyasami Iyer was a scholar and teacher of music. Thus, music was in her genes and she began to learn classical Carnatic music even as a tiny tot. As an attractive lass, she accompanied her mother in the latter's concerts singing seconds ('pin paattu').

In her teens, she became the disciple of G. N. Balasubramaniam, and it was a turning point in her life and career. She imbibed all that was best in her guru's musical genius and added her own to the inheritance. The MLV family then lived in the Anna Pillai Street area of George Town, Madras.

During the December 1946 music festival in Madras, the renowned musical duo Alathur Brothers were scheduled to sing in a Sabha but, for some personal reasons, they could not make it. Much to the surprise of many, the eighteen-year-old Vasanthakumari took their place and sang! Her performance, scintillatingly sensational, took the listeners by storm. That night a new star rose on the classical Carnatic music horizon...

The January 5, 1947 issue of the popular Tamil weekly 'Ananda Vikatan' reviewed her performance in its 'Aadal Paadal' pages, showering praise on her but commented that she was imitating GNB too much! It also published a passport-size photograph of MLV in which she looked very attractive!

Because of her good looks and singing talents, not surprisingly, motion picture producers went after her to get her into movies. One of them was the powerful Tamil film producer of his day, SM. Letchumanan Chettiar (better known as 'Lena Chettiar') of Krishna Pictures. MLV appeared in a single scene in Lena's Tamil production, a musical movie, 'Krishna Bhakthi' (1948).

In this film she sings, in a king's court, 'Entha vedukondhu O'Raghava', a popular composition of Saint Thyagaraja Swamigal in the raga Saraswathi Manohari. Slim and sensuously attractive, MLV looked impressive on screen. And her accompanying artistes were all women. The on-screen 'mridangam' player was Kumari N. Rajam, who was an adept in playing on that inimitable percussion instrument. During the song recording, S. V. S. Narayanan, the noted mridangam artiste of the day, played on that instrument. Kumari Rajam 'acted' the scene well because she was herself a mridangam player.

(Narayanan was the son of S. V. Subbaiah Bhagavathar of 'Jayajaya Gokulabala' fame, the singing stage and screen star of yesteryears. He too appeared in a single scene in 'Krishna Bhakthi' playing on the mridangam in the famous and brilliant 'Kathakaalakshepam' sequence by the hero, P.U. Chinnappa. Sadly, Narayanan passed away young without his talents flowering to full bloom.)

(Attractive, slim and talented, Kumari Rajam received training in fine arts and could sing and dance well. As 'Baby' Rajam, she was a popular musician in the early 1940s. In her youthful years, she was a model for the 'Lux Beauty Soap' ads. She played major and supporting roles in films like 'Dhana Amaravathi' (1947), 'Ithu Nijama?' (1948), 'Ezha Padum Paadu' (1950, one of the classics of Tamil cinema), 'Pavalakodi' (1949) and 'Krishna Bhakthi'. Sadly, her screen career did not take off as expected. Later, under the name 'Thanjavur N. Rajalakshmi' she emerged as a successful classical dance-teacher and choreographer and, now, she runs a Bharathanatyam Dance School in Madras with disciples coming not only from India but also Singapore and Malaysia. She teaches Carnatic music too. Now in her eighties, she is still young in sprits and bubbling with life and cheer and is a rich granary of film history and anecdotes of many hues about Tamil movie's men and women and musicians of the never-to-return, gone-over-the-horizon decades.)

23 'pedestrian-friendly' streets planned in T. Nagar

Under the 'Smart City' project, 23 pedestrian-friendly streets are to come up in T. Nagar.

According to a senior Corporation official, out of the Central fund of Rs. 380 crores received for the project recently, Rs. 23 crores will be allocated for developing pedestrian-friendly streets under the Area Development Programme.

"The proposed pedestrian zones will be designed in such a manner as to encourage more people to give up motor transport. Entry for vehicles will be restricted to one side of the road in some of the 23 interior roads", he said.

To appease the shopkeepers who are against the proposed pedestrian plaza fearing they will lose business, provision has been made in the design for shoppers to park light motor vehicles on the road side.
