It is likely to fall anytime.


It poses a danger to unwary pedestrians who

TAMIL CINEMA 75 - A LOOK BACK

TAMIL CINEMA AND MUSIC - 58

The Tharai Ticket Aasaami (TTA) could whistle at the goings on on screen or sneeze on cue if the lovers on screen got too close for a kiss! Such joys and privileges were denied to the better-placed person on the higher classes of bench or chair!

Rajam saw many silent films in a tent cinema located in an open space behind the P.S. High School compound. To his last days he remembered the name of a movie he saw decades ago in parts 'Nal Damayanthi', produced in Northern India! Obviously, it was the second version of the familiar tale made in 1927 by the founding father of Indian Cinema, Dadasaheb Phalke at Nasik. It was 8123 feet in length. Rajam evidently saw the Phalke movie of 1927, which was possibly screened in parts! He was then in his preteens.

The first permanent movie house of Mylapore, Kapali Talkies, came up in late 1930s and, until the recent years, it served the Mylai-wasis well. In that era, it was rather isolated with areas like Raja Annamalaipuram, Mandavelipakkam, and such not having come to existence.

The first superstar of South India of India, M. K. Thyagaraja Bhagavathar, inaugurated Kapali Theater for which he was given a silver hammer as memento!

(There have been fanciful explanations why a hammer, of all the things, was given but none of them is complimentary to poor MKT!)

(Foreigners especially Americans wonder why movie houses in India are called "Talkies"! One American diplomat in Madras asked this writer what that word meant! In the early days, movie house or tents screened only silent films. When movies began to talk English in 1927, and Hindi, Tamil and Telugu in 1931, Kannada in 1934, and Malayalam 1938, cinemas acquired sound equipment and the theaters came to be known as 'talkies' as opposed to places screening silent films. For some time, even after movies began to talk in India, silent films were still being made in south India. To distinguish the two, the word 'talkies' was used in India. (This word is not in use in the West.)

Meanwhile, back at Kolhapur, then a 'native' state ruled by a maharajah, V. Shantaram, one of the greatest filmmakers of India then, making his way in movies with the celebrated Prabhat Pictures, wrote to a Madras-based movie magazine, "Sound and Shadow" seeking help to make a Tamil film using the sets, props and all of his Hindi film, "Sairandhri" (1933, India's first film in color). The film had not done well and the company was trying to cut its losses by launching a Tamil film using the same re-usable materials. The magazine was being run by the talented trio, Muthuswami Iyer (later filmmaker under the name, 'Murugadasa'), A. K. Sekhar (art director, production designer, and master of all, and later a big name in South Indian Cinema), and K. Ramnoth (brilliant technician and genius of Tamil cinema, sadly neglected today). A rich impresario and fine arts-lover, and talent-scout and all, G. K. Seshagiri, financially backed them.

Soon the trio, Seshagiri, the Mylapore lawyer Sundaram Iyer, his children Rajam, Jayalakshmi and the youngest son, the seven year old prodigy, S. Balachandar and members of an amateur drama troupe boarded a train at Madras to Miraj (a railway junction) en route to Kolhapur.

Accompanying them was Papanasam Sivan as music composer, blissfully unaware as the train chug/chugged its way that he was on his way to fame and fortune!

Rajam faced a movie camera for the first time in "Seetha Kalyanam" (1933). A Prabhat production, it was directed by the well-known Marathi and Hindi filmmaker of his day, Baburao Phendarkar.

Interestingly, the so-called Tamil film historians, in their blissful ignorance, have been writing and speaking in Tamil and English spreading misinformation about the making of Seetha Kalyanam". (To be continued)

Aadhaar must for opening bank accounts

The government has made Aadhaar mandatory for opening new bank accounts and conducting financial transactions of Rs. 50,000 and above. Existing bank account holders have to submit a copy of their Aadhaar card to their respective bank branches by December 31, 2017, failing which their accounts will cease to be operational.

For companies opening bank accounts, Aadhaar number/(s) of the authorized signatory/signatories will have to be provided.

If a person does not have an Aadhaar number at the time of opening of account, he or she has to furnish proof of application for enrolment in Aadhaar and submit the number to the bank within six months of opening of the account.

The notification has also mandated the quoting of Aadhaar number along with permanent account number (PAN) or Form 60 by individuals, companies and partnership firms for all financial transactions of Rs. 50,000 and above.

Residents discuss long pending issues

"Let the smart city plan be for the future. The need of the hour is proper basic facilities and resolving of the several pending civic issues", is what most residents had to say during a meeting held last week. The residents' meeting was held on June 18 in Tanjore Road to discuss the long-pending issues in their locality. "Where is the question of a smart city, when poor sanitation and appalling road conditions have not been addressed for decades", said Prabhakar, the president of Tanjore Road Residents' Welfare Association. "I have been a resident of the neighbourhood for over 65 years and several streets that were dug up for constructing storm water drains, have not been relaid", he added. "Encroachments are rampant on the main roads which are occupied by street hawkers. Vendors and roadside eateries dump their waste in the bins reserved for residents, which attracts stray cattle and dogs. Sweepers are not regular in cleaning the roads", he complained. He further said that the sewage lines in T. Nagar have not been relaid for over 65 years. S. Jayaraman (a resident of T. Nagar for 25 years), said that roads are being relaid without milling. It means the level of the ground floor of the older houses will become lower than the level of the relaid roads leading to flooding during heavy rains intermixed with sewage water thereby exposing the residents to communicable diseases. Jayaraman, who also moderates a Facebook page for T. Nagar residents, said that water is becoming a serious issue for the residents as wells deeper than 25 feet are starting to yield pale yellow water. This has increased the need to depend on tanker lorries for everyday consumption.
