Eight abduct father of job racketeer, held

 The police arrested 8 graduates who kidnapped the father of a businessman who allegedly

cheated them of Rs. 2 lakhs by promising them jobs. The businessman's father has also been detained based

on a complaint from the graduates.

According to police, Imran, son of Muhammed Rafiq, is a resident of K.K. Nagar and runs a placement company in Valasaravakkam. He allegedly collected Rs. 2 lakhs from 8 graduates promising placement abroad.

He failed to do so and absconded.

The graduates came to Imran's house in K.K. Nagar on Sept. 26 and found his car parked there. They met his father Rafiq who said he was not aware of his son's whereabouts.

This infuriated them and they took away Rafiq in Imran's car to blackmail Imran and get their money back.

Based on a complaint lodged by Rafiq's friend, the police traced the whereabouts of the kidnappers with the help of a mobile tower location based on the calls made by them.

Police nabbed all the kidnappers and rescued Rafiq the next day.

During enquiry, it was found that the graduates had filed a complaint against Imran with the City Crime Branch on Aug. 24. The CCB team had started investigating the complaint, but Imran was reported to be absconding.

Further investigation is on.

2 held for assaulting film producer in lift

Varun told the police that the two assaulted him and tried to stab him with screwdrivers they were carrying. Varun sustained injuries in his hand.

The two were handed over to the Saidapet police who are investigating the case.

British-period lamp posts relocated in coastal areas

In a novel initiative, lamp posts dating to the pre-independence era are being given a new lease of life. Around 200 vintage cast iron lamp posts from areas in and around T. Nagar have been removed and installed in coastal areas in Pariyakuppam, Chinnakuppam in Ennore, Kotivakkam and Tiruvottiyur.

According to Corporation officials, the idea was mooted in the wake of the cyclone in December 2016 when several street light poles were uprooted in the coastal areas. "The 75-year-old cast iron lamp posts came in handy to replace the damaged poles because they do not rust," an official said.

The cast iron lamp posts, five meters tall, are three times heavier than the new metal-sheet lamp posts which weigh 60 kg.

Corporation proposes to offer five more services online

Chennai Corporation has proposed to offer five new services online, including birth and death certificate correction, inclusion of child name, application for building permission and one time assessment of property tax. At present, it offers 11 of its services online.

The proposal has been mooted by the Planning Department.

However, officers in the Public Health Department said that the move is 'not feasible'.

Concerns are being raised about the risks attached to providing correction services online.

"If a third person could raise a request without the knowledge of the person concerned, and if such a request is processed, then we will be in trouble," said a health department official.

"We cannot do away with physical verification as is being done now," the officer added.

TAMIL CINEMA 75 - A LOOK BACK

The famous Tamil writer 'Sandilyan' (real name -Bhashyam) was associated with Chittoor V.Nagaiah intimately during the B. N. Reddi-Vauhini days. He later went to meet his old friend Nagaiah in a city studio. The famed writer was shocked to see his old pal dressed in a bizarre and outlandish cowboy costume and holding a rifle made of bamboo. He was sitting under a tree waiting for the shot and, when the writer met him and expressed his anguish about the sad state of affairs, Nagaiah replied, Bhashyam, udhara nimitham bahukrutha vesham!" (A Sanskrit proverb which means that, for the sake of the stomach, one has to play many roles.). Sandilyan had tears in his eyes when he narrated this incident to this writer many years later.

In the 1950s, the Indian Government bestowed on Nagaiah the 'Padma Sri' award. When this writer called on him to offer his congratulations, Nagaiah remarked, My dear boy, I have only 'Padmam' and no Sri!" He meant that he had only fame but not fortune.

One time this writer went to meet him along with a friend who was a great admirer of the star. After some small talk, the friend told the great man that he had never witnessed a film shooting. Nagaiah took down his name and address in some corner of the city. Months later, this writer was astonished when the friend told him over the phone that one morning Nagaiah came to his house in a hired vehicle and took the entire family to watch a film shooting. At that time, he was down and out facing many hardships in life and yet he went out to of the way at much expense to make a casual acquaintance happy. Such men are rare and perhaps exist only in the pages of fiction. However, Nagaiah was a real man of Old World values and culture &

Nagaiah had many human qualities rarely seen in human beings in this world. He had the habit of saluting every traffic constable he came across while going in his car. When he was asked about it he replied, These people stand all day under the hot sun only to help us and guide us to drive safely & we do not pay or even tip them and the least we could do is to salute them." Such was his kind heart and concern for his fellow human beings

Nagaiah maintained an open house and all 'comers-and goers' took full advantage of his hospitality. His generosity often exceeding the limits was one of the causes of his financial ruin. He did not also know who his real friends were and many took full advantage of his goodness.

If the great actor and adorable man died in penury, one of the many causes was the person himself. Sadly after his demise he was forgotten by the ungrateful world but a few old friends and admirers led by the veteran Telugu film journalist and scholar Inturi Venkateswara Rao who succeeded after much struggle to erect a statue of Nagaiah inside the Paanagal Park in T. Nagar, Madras (now Chennai), near the area where he lived most of his life in the city.

This writer owes a lot to this great soul. He can never forget the lessons Nagaiah taught him in acting and also filmmaking when he was still a kid in half pants who had absolutely no idea that he would one day land in the world of lens and lights! That is the way the ball bounces in life, as they say...

Here was a man, when comes such another!

Steep increase in dengue cases in the city

Two children have died of dengue in Chennai and its outskirts since Sept. 24.

Of the nearly 900 hospitalised with high fever, 40 are infected with the dengue virus.

On Sept. 25, Krithik Ram (8-year-old son of a police inspector) died of liver failure caused by dengue in Apollo Children's Hospital. The same day, a student of DAV School, Gopalapuram, died of multiple-organ failure caused by dengue in Kanchi Kamakoti Childs Trust Hospital. On Sept. 22, a third year student of IIT-Madras died of multiple-organ failure after being diagnosed with dengue.

According to city health officer Dr. N. Senthilnathan, they have stepped up surveillance, including door-to-door inspection as there quite a few fever cases have been reported. He has appealed to the public to ensure that there is no stagnation of water in and around houses, indoors or outside.

He said that Aedes mosquitoes usually breed in clean stagnant water.

The warning signs of the viral fever include high temperature, rashes, headache, joint pain and body ache. If not treated early, it can cause drop in blood platelet levels, internal bleeding, haemorrhage and death.
