Security beefed up for Deepavali

With Deepavali fast approaching, the police are gearing up to provide additional security for the increased flow of shoppers to T. Nagar.

"100 police personnel have been deployed and the number will be increased to around 400 as Deepavali nears," said A. K. Viswanathan (Police Commissioner).

Apart from the permanently installed CCTV cameras, three watch towers are being erected and 34 additional cameras have

been installed at sensitive locations to monitor the crowd.

Temporary control rooms have been set up near the junction of Usman Road and Duraiswamy subway and in T. Nagar police station for monitoring the CCTV cameras.

According to an official, 30 woman constables will be used as decoys and will be provided with photos and other details of habitual criminals and chain snatchers.

Flex boards with pictures of pickpockets have also been displayed at important junctions.

Shop owners have been told to ensure the working of the CCTV cameras in their shops.

The traffic department has earmarked locations near schools to facilitate parking for the increased inflow of vehicles. The side lanes of South Usman Road will be closed to vehicles from Sunday, Oct. 8, to decongest traffic and make them pedestrian-friendly for shoppers. The Fire Service will also be fully geared up for emergencies.

Level in city reservoirs at 6% of capacity

The combined storage of 713 mcft in the city's reservoirs as of Oct. 5 was 6% of their total capacity of 11,057 mcft.

It was 221.14 mcft on Sept. 5.

The storage has more than doubled due to good rainfall in September in the city and surroundings.

But with water level still only at 6% of capacity, the city still stares at a water crisis unless

it receives copious rains this monsoon.

Poondi has 77 mcft as against its capacity of 3231 mcft (212 mcft on the same day last year); Cholavaram has 52 mcft (capacity 881 mcft, 96 mcft last year), Red Hills has 286 mcft (capacity 3300 mcft, 660 mcft last year)

and Chembarampakkam has 298 mcft (capacity 3645 mcft, 920 mcft last year).

Corporation land to be acquired for Kodambakkam Police Station

The Police Dept. will acquire a 3765 sq.ft plot from Chennai Corporation at a cost of Rs. 2.59 crores to for a new building to house R-2 Kodambakkam Police Station.

A special officer's council has given in-principle approval for the transfer of land rights on full payment of the amount to the Corporation. The plot is located between Corporation Division 31 Office and the Corporation Community Centre in Corporation Colony Road, Kodambakkam. A resting room for conservancy workers, a dressing room, a plastic shredder machine room and an Anganwadi are currently located in the plot.

A Corporation official told *Mambalam Times* that one child is taken care of in the Anganwadi and she will be shifted to the Anganwadi in Kamaraj Colony. "The rest of the building, though in use, is in a dilapidated condition", he added.

"We will soon pay for the land and issue tenders via the Police Housing Corporation," said a police officer.

The R-2 Kodambakkam Police Station is now located in Trustpuram, Kodambakkam.

TAMIL CINEMA 75 - A LOOK BACK

TAMIL CINEMA AND MUSIC - 73

THE MULTIFACETED GENIUS S. BALACHANDAR

One of the stormy petrels of the South Indian art world, a brilliant person with his share of delightful eccentricities, he was an actor, screenwriter, film producer, music composer, innovative celluloid creator and above all an acknowledged genius of classical Carnatic music. During a certain period of his life, he was active in Tamil Cinema, playing roles of different kinds and also making movies, many of which attracted wide attention. Much influenced by Hollywood cinema, the films he directed had a touch of the west in the story content and music. Even though he was a conservative classical Carnatic musician, he invested his film music with different schools of Western music like jazz and Latin American melodies and rhythms and such. That was a period when such genres of music were a novelty in Tamil cinema. Such a multifaceted personality was S. Balachander (1927 - 1990).

Of the many films in which he was associated with as actor or director, mention should be made of 'Rishya Shringar' (1941), 'Ithu Nijama?' (1948), 'Kaithi' (1951, also directed by him), 'Rajambal' (1951), 'Anthana Naal' (1954, story and direction), 'Avana Ivan?' (1962), 'Bomma' (1964), and 'Nadu Iravil' (1970). Of all these films, 'Anthana Naal' came to be hailed as a classic of South Indian cinema, being the first movie to be produced in the part of the country without the usual and obligatory routine song-and-dance sequences.

Sundaram Balachander was the son of the Mylapore lawyer V. Sundaram Iyer, and, as a young boy, he went along with his father, handsome brother Rajam and sister Jayalakshmi to Kolhapur from Madras to act in the Prabhat Pictures' Tamil film 'Seetha Kalyanam' (1933). Even as a mere lad, 'Chandru', as he was called by his family and friends, revealed his genius and interest in music.

While his brother and sisters learned music under the legendary musician and composer Papanasam Sivan, the lad hung around in the family house in Mylapore, absorbing the music by mental osmosis. He also revealed a flair to play on musical instruments, which would help him in large measure later when he became a film music composer.

Impressed immensely by his genius, the producers cast him in 'Seetha Kalyanam' as a musician in the court of the mighty King Ravana to play the percussion instrument 'kanjeera'. He astonished everybody present on the set with his amazing proficiency in playing the instrument which is held by the left hand and rhythms played with the right hand! During the shooting of the scenes he proved more than a problem to the director Baburao Prebendary. While playing on the kanjeera he would be lost in his own world and would wander all over the set and in and out of the film frame, and sometimes marching and swaying, making faces, right up to the camera! Exasperated to the brim, the director drew a circle with a chalk and ordered the boy not to move out of it warning him that, if he did, he would not get any food and other goodies like chunks of creamy ice cream!

During the making of the movie at Kolhapur, Chandru did not have many scenes but he did not waste the spare hours. He evinced great interest in the many musical instruments used in the orchestra and worked hard to learn them. Thus, he learnt to play with ease and efficiency the sitar. Later Rajam and Chandru toured many parts of northern India with Rajam giving vocal concerts and Chandru accompanying him on the sitar. While performing at Karachi (then part of India and now in Pakistan) the audience was so impressed with the young lad's mastery over the sitar that the patrons who organised the concert presented him a silver sitar.

MTC demanding Aadhaar copy for issuing free tokens

Sir, I understand that the Metropolitan Transport Corporation (MTC) is now making it mandatory for senior citizens to submit a copy of the Aadhaar card to avail of free coupons. Earlier they were issued based on the ration card.

Those who queue up to get the coupons are surprised by this sudden development. Many have had to return empty handed and re-visit bus depots with Aadhaar card copies. The result is that every depot is besieged with serpentine queues formed by

the elders. One does not understand why all of a sudden MTC is asking for Aadhaar card more so when things were well set and coupons were being issued without hassles. If Aadhaar details are shared, it loses its value and there is a good chance of it getting misused. Just for the ten free round trip tokens a month, seeking Aadhaar card copy is too much. Is MTC suddenly questioning the veracity of ration cards on the basis of which it has been issuing free tokens over the past couple of years? **V. S. Jayaraman, 31, Motilal Street, T. Nagar**

Separate counter needed for free bus tokens

Sir, I am a senior citizen. On Oct. 3, I went to T. Nagar Bus Depot to get the free senior citizen bus tokens when I saw a number of persons standing in line in the hot sun to get them.

Suddenly, without notice, the counter was closed and the staff asked us to come in the evening. When we protested, he said that he was short of tokens and he also had to issue regular season passes as the office is short on manpower. It is difficult for senior citizens to

go multiple times and stand in the queue to get the tokens.

I appeal to MTC officials to open a separate counter for senior citizens for issuing the free tokens. I also suggest that instead of restricting the number to 10 tokens per month issued three months in advance, MTC can issue 30 token to be used within three months. It does not cause any additional burden for MTC but gives more flexibility of time to the commuter to use the tokens. **R. Lakshmanan, T. Nagar**

Residents' plea to widen foot overbridge and evict hawkers

Following the stampede that killed 20 persons in Elphinstone railway station in Mumbai on Sept. 29, residents of the neighbourhood have appealed to Southern Railway to widen the narrow foot overbridge in Mambalam Station that ends on Ranganathan Street and evict hawkers occupying both the new and old overbridges.

Mambalam station is one of the most crowded suburban stations in the city as it links T. Nagar, one of the busiest commercial areas in Chennai.

With Deepavali coming up, lakhs of shoppers from Chennai and nearby areas are expected to utilize the suburban service to reach T. Nagar.

According to a senior member of T. Nagar

Residents Welfare Association, Southern Railway should depute staff or make arrangements with Railway Reserve Police to regulate crowds entering and leaving the station in the ensuing days till Deepavali.

The tragedy of Mumbai is a hard lesson and steps should be taken to widen the foot overbridge, he said.

Last year, a new foot overbridge was constructed connecting Mambalam Railway Station with Mambalam High Road (near Duraisamy subway), but most commuters prefer to use the older bridge due to its proximity to the shopping hub.

Further, hawkers are encroaching on both the overbridges, thereby further narrowing their usable width.
