## Tamil encyclopedia, brainchild of a Chennai resident, released

The World Tamil Encyclopedia, the first of its kind and a seminal addition to Tamil language and heritage, was recently released in Chennai.

Compiled through 12 years of painstaking effort, the 3-volume book is the brainchild of Prof. Dr. E. J. Sundar, a resident of Anna Nagar.

According to Dr. Sundar, former Tamil Professor of A. M. Jain College, the encyclopedia features 16,500 entries in 2141 pages, and is a comprehensive compilation of all things related to Tamil, Tamilnadu and Tamilians.

Dato Jothinathan of Malaysia, founder of Uma Publications, is the publisher of the work. Late Dr. K. P. Aravaanan, former Vice Chancellor of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, was Special Advisor. Fifty subject matter experts contributed to the book, with Nalankilli serving as Editor.

World Tamil Encyclopedia covers topics relating to Tamil literature, arts, history, religion and more, and also compiles relevant information from other countries where Tamilians have established themselves.

Readers can easily access information by searching through the 39 topics in the book which include architecture, tourism, geography, agriculture, zoology, festivals, celebrities, industries, medicine and cinema.

The entries are also alphabetized for easy access. With its massive breadth of coverage, World Tamil Encyclopedia has entries on 800 magazines that have been published in Tamil, Tamilnadu's 96 rivers, 760 Tamil literary works, the 600 towns of Tamilnadu, 720 plant and 230 animal/bird species unique to the State, 145 industrial units, 4000 Tamil movies released till 2016, pilgrimage sites, Tamil Eezham and much more.

Dr. Sundar told *Mambalam Times*, "It would not be an exaggeration to claim that this book is a free standing library on its own and carries an equivalent of a hundred other books in terms of content".

The 3 volumes together are priced at Rs. 3,000. Its distributor in India is Rythm Book Publishers.

**Garbage dumped in vacant plot**



**Dept. of Posts trains, employs poor womwn**

The Chennai City Central Division, Department of Posts, is training underprivileged women living in slum areas in the city to earn their livelihood.

Under this program, 15 women from the fishing hamlet of Nochikuppam are being trained in pre-mailing services such as labelling and addressing business and bulk mails.

The Postal Department has trained and offered similar jobs in the T. Nagar post office to residents of slums.

The Department also plans to extend such daily wage jobs to more persons from the marginalised sections of society

It held camps for several groups such as street vendors, fisherwomen, restaurant workers, drivers, patients affected by leprosy and transgender persons.

**Two RO drinking water booths installed in Ashok Nagar**

RO based drinking water booths were installed by Chennai Corporation in 10th Avenue, Ashok Nagar and at the junction of Muthalamman Koil Street and 24th Street, Ashok Nagar at a cost of Rs. 7 lakhs each.

An official told *Mambalam Times* that purified drinking water will be distributed with the help of smart cards and 20 liters of water is delivered for each swipe of the card.

He said that though the booth will function from 8 a.m to 8 p.m, a person will be available 24 hours to provide water to needy persons anytime. He said that the plant has a capacity to purify and supply 2000 liters of water per hour.

**Don't pay for sports facilities in Corporation parks**

All parks maintained by Chennai Corporation are free for the public, but it has been reported that the person-in-charge in some parks is charging for use of a few facilities like sports equipment.

At the skating rink in Natesan Park on Venkatanarayana Road, T. Nagar while the coaching is termed free, amounts varying from Rs. 2,500 to Rs. 6,000 are collected for the use of the kits varying in quality and period of training.

It has also been reported that a fee is charged for using the badminton court in Panagal Park under the pretext of maintenance.

A park official told *Mambalam Times* all services in the Corporation Parks in the city are free, He said that while sports facilities are outsourced to contractors, no fee was required to be paid to access the facilities.

He has appealed to park users to lodge complain if they are asked to pay to use any facility.

**Another sub-station in K. K. Nagar**

The construction of a new sub-station on Munusamy Salai, K. K. Nagar has commenced.

According to an EB official, the additional sub-station is being constructed to meet the extra power demand from K.K. Nagar and Nesapakkam.

The 110 kv sub-station will be ready in 15 months, he said.

## Students develop app to map house sparrows

To map the dwindling sparrow population, students of the Eco Club in Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering have developed a mobile application for public use to crowd-source information about the bird.

To mark International Sparrow Day on March 20, the app, 'SoS - Save Sparrow', was launched to enable users to pin the location of the sighting of a house sparrow.

Users can take a photograph of the bird or its nest and this data can be uploaded. Using this app a sparrow map in the city can be created that shows the distribution of the bird's population in various parts of Chennai.

"After recording sizable sightings, this data will be transferred to the e-bird portal," said K. Jaswanth, one of the students who developed the app.

The Eco Club, along with Environmental Monitoring and Action Initiating (EMAI), is part of the team that developed the app.

Vishnu Kumar of EMAI said that the organisation is also distributing sparrow nests that can be kept in residential areas.

"Before taking the nests, residents have to confirm that sparrows have been spotted in their neighbourhood," he said.

Principal of the college Ganesh Vaidyanathan said: "The project sparrow was initiated by the Eco Club five years back. Now, the students have used technology to make a difference in nature conservation."

Nests have been distributed in some residential areas in north Chennai such as Royapuram, New Washermenpet, Thiruvottiyur, Mannady, Parrys Corner and Chintadripet as these areas have old tiled houses which attract sparrows.



**Thanks to residents' protest, media publicity, plan to shift ration shops dropped**

Sir, We thank *Mambalam Times* for publishing the report on residents' protests against the shifting of the ration shops bearing Nos. HC 007 and HC 009 from Rameswaram Street, T. Nagar to Mambalam High Road which is more than a kilometer away.



The shops cater to the residents of streets abutting Usman Road, Soundarajan Street, Ramanujam Street and Gandhi Street.

In an effort to stall the move, T. Nagar Residents' Welfare Association took up the issue with various officials of Civil Supplies, Tamil Nadu Urban Co-operative Society (TUCS) and the Joint Registrar (Public Distribution System).

The proposal to shift the shops was due to political pressure on the officials of TUCS which runs the two shops.

Further, the shops are now functioning in the premises owned by TUCS and the premises at the new location in Mambalam High Road would have been rented.

As a direct consequence of residents' persistence aided by media reports, an official from the Joint Registrar visited the shops to take stock of the situation.

All this has led the authorities to drop the proposal to shift the shops.

**Garbage woes in Umapathy Street-Thambiah Road junction**

**Low pressure affects water supply in Lake View Road Extension**

Sir, I am a resident of Lake View Road Extension, West Mambalam. It falls under Zone 10, Division 140.

We receive metro water only on alternate days for 1 or 2 hours in the morning. Often the water supplied is contaminated with sewage water. As the pressure is low, the sumps do not fill up and the supply is insufficient to meet our day-to-day requirement.

Metrowater officials say that the street being at the tail end of the Division, the pressure is low and they are helpless. I feel the pressure is low as either the valve that connects to our pipeline has not been opened fully or the pumping pressure is low at the main station.

The residents of the street are forced to buy water from tankers to meet their needs in spite of paying Metrowater tax.

I appeal to Metrowater officials to increase the pressure in the waterline so that we get the regular supply received by the residents of nearby streets. **R. Kripanandan**

**Save water to tide over crisis**

Sir, We are heading for a scorching summer with impending water crisis due to failure of the monsoon for the past 2 years. To conserve water, we have to use it judiciously. For starters, it is estimated that each flush of the western toilet consumes around 10 liters and each person, on an average, flushes around 5 times a day. This can be considerably reduced by reducing the volume of the cistern or by adjusting the level of the floating ball to reduce the quantity of water used per flush. I have personally used this method successfully. It is estimated that an apartment complex with about 50 persons can save 400 liters of water per day using this method. In fact, there is a move by Indian Standards Organization to use only cisterns with a dual control method of operation for new constructions, one initiating a full flush and the other initiating a half flush depending on the need.
