Elector-population ratio highest in T. Nagar

Chennai District Election Office has reported a rise in the elector-population ratio in constituencies. The ratio of electors for a given population in the Assembly segments is calculated ahead of polls to assess the impact of deletion and inclusion in the rolls. Chennai District, with a population of 49.59 lakhs as per 2019 projections, has included 38.66 lakh electors on the rolls so far, following an increase of more than 70,000 in the past few weeks.

T. Nagar has reported the highest number of voters for a given population, with an elector-population ratio of 87. 2.31 lakh voters have been enrolled in the areas which have an estimated 1,38,845 men and 1,37,843 women.

Four burglaries in 3 days in West Mambalam, Vadapalani

Two masked men entered the residence of Sampath (53) in West Mambalam and decamped with 3 kg. of silver and Rs. 5,000 in cash in the small hours of April 11. Following his complaint, Mambalam police are going through the CCTV images of the building to identify the culprits.

Two thefts occurred on April 9 and 10 in Vadapalani.

On April 10, burglars robbed 4 sovereigns gold jewellery and Rs. 1 lakh in cash from a locked house in Bakthavatchalam Street, Vadapalani.

In another case, Rs.80,000 was robbed from another locked house in Vadapalani and Rs. 14,000 from the locked office of Gurumurthy in Arcot Road.

The police have collected CCTV footage to identify the robbers. A special team has been formed to arrest the robbers.

Local drama troupe stages street play on water conservation

Theatrekaran, a drama troupe founded by youngsters in West Mambalam, staged a street play on water conservation recently.

Around 15 young men and women staged the play to stress the necessity to preserve water at various levels.

The play also mentioned the data given by World Health Organisation on decreasing resources all over the world.

Sabarivas and Raghavendra (Founder Members), who are longtime residents of West Mambalam, told *Mambalam Times* that the water crisis is worsening year after year.

To make the show interesting, the team used the popular cartoon character Popeye, to convey its message effectively.

It was divided into various parts, highlighting points like three minutes bathing, avoiding running water from tap for vessel cleaning and distributing unused bottles of water in marriages among needy people in slums and other areas. The team can be reached in 98849 66613, 91769 96508.

6 tonnes banned plastic seized in T. Nagar

In a citywide operation last week, 50 tonnes of banned plastic items were seized from several shopkeepers of which T. Nagar accounted for 6 tonnes.

Officials of Chennai Corporation have intensified the drive against 14 throwaway plastic items banned by the State Government. The biggest seizures were in Kodambakkam, Ambattur, Royapuram, Teynampet and Perungudi. The seized plastic is sent to the pyrolysis plant in Perungudi to be converted into fuel and also used for laying roads, said an official.

The official said that Rs.50 lakhs has been allotted to create awareness among the public and commercial establishments at zonal and ward levels. The Corporation also plans to conduct workshops and exhibitions in which all stakeholders including shop owners, manufacturers of alternative products and resident welfare associations will be involved.

Talking about penalties and other legislation, the officials said they had sent a draft to the state government for which sanction is expected after the election.

175 kg. gold bars worth Rs. 56 crores seized near Chennai

A state police team seized 175 kg. of gold bars worth Rs. 56 crores from a van during a vehicle check on Chennai's outskirts on May 9 night. The van was part of a three-vehicle convoy.

While the seven men in the vehicles said they were transporting the gold to a state government office in T. Nagar and produced documents as proof, police said they had seized the consignment as they were not sure of its authenticity.

According to police, around midnight, a special team stationed at the Arambakkam checkpoint on the TN-Andhra Pradesh border stopped the vehicles coming towards Chennai from the neighbouring state as part of the nationwide effort to curb illegal cash flow during polls.

A check found seven boxes, each containing 25 gold bars, in the van that was sandwiched between two vehicles. There were four men, including two armed guards, in the van that had two CCTV cameras.

Though they produced some papers, police sent the cargo to the Gummidipondi Tahsildar's office.

"The men claimed they were employees of a private firm authorized by the Reserve Bank of India to import gold," said an officer from the Gummidipondi police station.

They claimed that the gold was being transported from the firm's godown in Sri City, Andhra Pradesh, to a government office in T. Nagar.

Last year, the school produced 100% pass percentage in Std. 10 board exams.

All students are trained in basic computer operation and tailoring.

Additionally, between 4 p.m and 5 p.m on school days,

students are encouraged to pursue any vocational subject they choose. A free snack is provided for such students.

During summer holidays, free summer camps are conducted and the students are trained in yoga, spoken English, advanced tailoring and computers. Metrowater cancels bookings for water supply

Sir, Several residents have informed us that Metrowater has cancelled their online booking for water tankers under the 'Dial for Water' scheme on the basis of multiple bookings made from the same apartment complex. Metrowater has no right to cancel booking even when multiple bookings are made by an apartment complex. It can at best only defer the supply rather than deny the supply of water. Metrowater provides only one water connection to complexes comprising of multiple flats but collects water charges individually from each flat owner.

So, each resident of an apartment complex has the right to make booking even if only one water connection is provided for the complex and it is the duty of Metrowater to supply water according to the order of booking.

Free bus passes instead of tokens better

Sir, At present, 30 free trip tokens are issued every quarter to senior citizens by MTC. A special ticket is issued by the bus conductors in exchange for the free token.

This process causes a little inconvenience not only for the senior citizens but also the MTC staff who have to make the appropriate entries in various big ledgers.

To avoid the inconvenience, the free bus pass can contain a tabular column with 12 rows (one for each month from January to December) and columns against each month. Whenever the commuter travels, the conductor can make a tick mark in the appropriate column, as is being done in the free bus passes issued to students. This will get rid of the burden of having to exchange free tokens for tickets during travelling.

Open side lanes to ease traffic congestion in Thyagaraya Road

Traffic problems near foot overbridge on Mambalam High Road

Sir, I am a resident of Mambalam High Road. For several years, there has been a severe traffic problem near the railway foot overbridge as the margins on both sides of the road are blocked by autos, cabs and private vehicles waiting to pick up passengers arriving in trains.

The autos start assembling by 4 a.m when long distance trains halt for alighting passengers. This goes on till 11 a.m and again resumes at around 3 p.m. The drivers also park the vehicles in a haphazard manner. Often the vehicles are parked in front of apartment complex entrances, blocking the apartment residents' right of passage.

With the arrival of the summer holidays, the situation has become worse.
