Tree branch falls on auto, driver dies

Autorickshaw driver Vijay (48), a resident of K. K. Nagar, died of injuries he sustained when the branch of a tree fell on his auto when he was driving on Rajamannar Salai (K. K. Nagar) at around 2 p.m on Nov. 28.

The top of the auto collapsed on Vijay and he suffered grievous injuries.

Passersby rescued him and admitted him in a nearby hospital where he died the same day.

K. K. Nagar police have registered a case.

Bomb threat to DMK headquarters, suspect held

The police on Nov. 22 arrested Ganeshan (37) from his house in SP Garden (T. Nagar) after he made a call threatening to bomb Anna Arivalayam, the DMK headquarters in Teynampet.

The call about the bomb sent police personnel and partymen into a tizzy on the night of Nov. 21 in the campus that houses the party office, Kalaignar TV and other offices on Anna Salai. Party leader M. K. Stalin had gone to Mumbai to attend the swearing-in of the new government led by Uddhav Thackeray.

The police control room received a call shortly after 8 p.m on Nov. 21. The caller claimed that he had planted a bomb in the campus and that it would go off soon. He then cut off the call abruptly. The message was conveyed to higher police officials by the staff of the control room. A team of the Bomb Detection and Disposal Squad (BDDS) of the city police and a sniffer dog unit reached Anna Arivalayam and checked the area. However, the call turned out to be a hoax.

Another team of police personnel traced the caller using his mobile number and arrested him from his house.

He was in an inebriated condition. He reportedly told police that he was a daily wagger and, out of frustration, he had called the control room and claimed that he had planted a bomb.

The move will entitle a family to get 5 kg. of rice per person (including a child) per month free of cost.

Sugar cardholders will have to submit applications with e xerox copies through the website www.tnpds.gov.in or to block supply officials and Asst. Commissioners of the civil supplies department in the region.

All cardholders now get 500 gm. per head a month subject to a maximum of 2 kg.

In the case of sugar cardholders, they are entitled to get 500 gm. per head a month plus an additional 3 kg. of sugar subject to a maximum of 5 kg. a month.

TANGEDCO not adjusting excess deposit against monthly bills

Sir, Last week, a resident of Motilal Street, T. Nagar, visited the TANGEDCO office located in Valluvarkottam to find the procedure to adjust the excess security deposit as shown in the monthly consumption bill raised by TNEB.

TNEB collects additional deposit every two years based on the average monthly consumption to cover 3 months charges.

A staff member told the resident that when the records were computerized in 2007 by outsourcing the work, wrong deposit details were incorporated, and hence the consumer has to provide the full details of payments made so far to avail of adjustment.

While it is a tall order to expect consumers to come up with the details, the contention of the staff member is not acceptable. While on this, when TANGEDCO continues to collect additional deposit based on this erroneous data, how does it become unreliable when it comes to adjusting the excess deposit? Further, the excess amount is not refunded, but adjusted towards the bills.

Contractors told to maintain Corporation parks properly

The Chennai Corporation on Nov. 25 gave a long checklist to its contractors in charge of maintaining 554 of its parks in the city to ensure that citizens do not have any grievances.

Commissioner G. Prakash held a review meeting with officials and contractors in Ripon Buildings during which the instructions were given. At present, the corporation has 669 parks of which 554 have been given to contractors. While 51 small parks are under the corporation's own staff, then rest are maintained by private companies and resident welfare organisations.

Contractors have been asked to ensure that even minor repair work in the parks is completed quickly and conduct monthly review meetings to monitor conditions. "Every park should utilise the space inside to build rain water harvesting structures," an official said.

Contractors have been asked to take sewage water from nearby residential colonies, treat it and use it for watering the plants in the parks.

To ensure that parks have proper security, contractors have been asked to build a separate room for the security staff. Other staff should not use this room for sleeping at night, the corporation said. "None of the staff employed should be more than 50 years old," the instruction stated.

The contractors have also been instructed to compost wet waste in all parks and use the manure for the trees and plants.

For prompt maintenance, personal safety equipment and other tools in working condition should be provided in all parks. "Action will be taken against contractors who do not employ the number of staff that they have been asked to as per the terms and conditions," an official said.

The Corporation has instructed contractors to ensure proper compliance with all state and central government labour laws pertaining to insurance and provident fund.

All the three Regional Deputy Commissioners, Principal Chief Engineer M. Pugazhendi, Chief Engineer (Parks) S. Kalimuthu and other zonal level officials participated in the meeting.
