Two arrested for robbery in local jewellery store

Suresh (43) (a resident of Kodambakkam) was arrested along with his girl friend on the charge of robbing a jewellery store in Moosa Street (T. Nagar) on Oct. 20.

They were identified by the police through CCTV cameras installed in the shop and

nearby roads. According to a police officer, their movements were recorded in 40 cameras. The footages showed two persons coming on a motorcycle and Suresh gaining entry into the locked shop and leaving with a bag.

Rajendra Kumar (the shop owner) told the police that 5 kg of gold and some silver ornaments were stolen. Police recovered 20 sovereigns of gold and 7 kg of silver from them. Three special teams were formed to crack the case.

Police tracked down Suresh's girlfriend and after questioning her, arrested

Suresh from Putlur in Tiruvallur.

Doctor on self-quarantine in T. Nagar hotel found dead

A 24-year-old doctor who was under self-quarantine in a hotel in T. Nagar was found dead in his room on the night of Oct. 26.

Lokesh Kumar of Mettur in Salem district, joined MS (General Surgery) in Madras Medical College in July and was posted in COVID-19 ward in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital since then.

"As per COVID-19 protocol, he was asked to go under self-quarantine and allotted a room in a hotel in T. Nagar. While he was supposed to return to duty on Oct. 27, his family could not reach him over phone as it was switched off. They then contacted the hotel staff to check his room," said a senior police officer. When the room was opened with a spare key, the hotel staff found Lokesh Kumar lying unconscious.

He was taken to Government Royapettah Hospital, where he was declared brought dead.

On information, Pandy Bazaar police registered a case and have launched an investigation.

Why not stipend for architects too?

Sir, The Tamilnadu Government has announced a stipend of Rs. 3000 per month for young lawyers for a period of two years to enable them to settle down. This is a very commendable step worth emulating by other states.

On similar grounds, I appeal to the Tamilnadu Government to consider granting a stipend for young architects in the state. Architecture is a highly specialised branch of education and one needs to really struggle hard to complete the five-year B.Arch. course. Even after completing the course one is not sure of employment. The role of an architect is only slowly gaining importance now.

The Government may consider passing an order requiring builders and individual house owners to append a qualified architect's endorsement of the drawing submitted for approval of building plan. Such a step will generate decent employment opportunities for qualified.

No opening of schools, theaters now

Schools, colleges and cinemas in Tamilnadu may have to remain closed for some more time. Citing hard-won gains against COVID-19, District Collectors and other top officials said that it would be prudent to bring down the numbers further before exploring the possibility of further relaxations.

At a meeting with Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami on Oct. 28, officials said that cinemas were a luxury at this point in time.

Noting that schools in countries like the UK had seen a surge in cases, they urged caution on the issue of reopening schools.

A senior official said that the State government was also waiting for the Centre to issue guidelines for the reopening of schools. It is also learnt that a member of the medical committee felt that the government could look at allowing students of Classes 9 to 12 to attend classes in school. "But overall, the feeling was that there should not be any hurry to reopen schools and colleges," the official said, adding that a few Collectors felt that a decision on reopening cinemas could be taken at a later date.

At the review meeting, Palaniswami said that a decision on representations received from the film industry for the reopening of cinemas would be taken based on inputs from Collectors and the medical committee.

Cops distribute scarves to thwart chain snatchers Security beefed up for Deepavali

To prevent chain snatching in the shopping hub of T. Nagar owing to the Deepavali shopping rush, the police have adopted a novel measure of distributing scarves free among women shoppers for covering the neck. The police also insist that women wear the scarves.



N. Hari Kiran Prasad (Deputy Commissioner of Police, T. Nagar) said, "We distribute 500 free scarves among shoppers daily. This has received good response from the public. We also distribute them at bus stands and other places." "As chain-snatching incidents happen mostly when women are on the move on the busy streets window shopping, we believe that scarves can deny the offenders a chance to strike," Prasad said. The scarves are given free at the entry point of the shopping

areas where the police also check the shoppers for fever before letting them into shops. M. Kalaiarasan (Mambalam inspector) said, "We distribute 500 free scarves among shoppers daily. This has received good response from the public. We also distribute them at bus stands and other places."

With Deepavali fast approaching, the police are gearing up to provide additional security for the increased flow of shoppers to T. Nagar. More than 1,200 CCTV cameras will be used to monitor the crowds and surveillance will also be carried out using drones, watch towers and camera fitted uniforms will be provided to the police personnel deployed to monitor the crowds. Specialized cameras with facial recognition technology have been installed on Usman Road, Ranganathan Street and outside Mambalam railway station to detect the presence of history-sheeters in the crowd. To ensure free movement, shop owners have been ordered not to encroach upon the free public space outside the shops with advertisement boards and other material. "100 police personnel have been deployed and the number will be increased to around 800 as Deepavali nears," said by D.N. Hari Kiran Prasad (Deputy Commissioner of Police, T. Nagar). Apart from the permanently installed CCTV cameras, three watch towers are being erected and 34 additional cameras have been installed at sensitive locations to monitor the crowd. Temporary control rooms will be set up near the junction of Usman Road and Duraiswamy subway and in T. Nagar police station for monitoring the CCTV cameras. According to an official, 30 woman constables will be used as decoys and will be provided with photos and other details of habitual criminals and chain snatchers. Flex boards with pictures of pickpockets have already been displayed at important junctions. Shop owners have been told to ensure the working of the CCTV cameras in their shops. The traffic department has earmarked locations near schools to facilitate parking for the increased inflow of vehicles. The Fire Service will also be fully geared up for emergencies.

Spurt in crowd in Ranganathan Street on Sunday
