## Covid norms flouted: 4 shopping complexes closed in T. Nagar

According to Corporation data, 925 shops were closed between May 6 and Sept. 18 for severe violation of Covid norms. Among the zones, the highest number of shops were closed in Valasaravakkam Zone (178) followed by Royapuram Zone (107). 38 shops including 4 commercial complexes were closed in T. Nagar.

Apart from closing the shops for serious violations, the Corporation has also collected fines from 9,108 shops and institutions for minor violations and from 75,198 individuals for not wearing masks.

As of Sept. 18, the Corporation had collected Rs. 4.46 crores as fine for violating Covid norms from shops and individuals. Since a special drive was launched on Sept. 16 to curb mask rule violation, 2,072 persons have been fined.

The maximum fine of Rs. 52.40 lakhs has been collected from 9,576 individuals and 1,330 shops in Kodambakkam Zone, in which Koyambedu Wholesale Market and the commercial hub of T. Nagar fall.

According to a Corporation official, a total of 200 teams (one for each Division) are in place to implement mask compliance. The teams comprise officials from Chennai Corporation and police.

## Construction labourer killed by fellow workers

Teynampet police arrested two construction labourers for allegedly murdering a co-worker on Sept. 22 night.

According to the police, S. Shankar (45) and B. Ragu (40) attacked the victim R. Vetrivel (41) with heavy stones after an argument ensued between them when they were drinking on Thyagaraya Road near a Tasmac outlet.

They fled from the spot after Vetrivel fell on the road with bleeding injuries in his head.

He died on Sept. 24 in Royappetah Government Hospital. Shankar and Raju were remanded to judicial custody.

# 2 more water treatment plants under construction

By January next year, The treated water from Metrowater will treat another 10 million liters of grey water a day before releasing it into water bodies. Work to set up treatment plants in Nesappakkam and Perungudi is nearing completion.

A senior Metrowater official said that 76% of work on the Nesappakkam plant has been completed and 66% on the Perungudi plant. While the Nesappakkam plant will become operational by January, the one in Perungudi will be ready by March 2022, the official said. Tertiary treated ultra-filtration technology will be used.

Each of the plants will have the capacity to treat 10 million liters of water a day. Presently, Metrowater is treating 90MLD of grey water in plants in Kodungaiyur and Koyambedu (each 45MLD capacity). Both the plants use reverse osmosis technology and the treated water from these two plants is potable, said the official. At present, 540MLD of grey water is generated in the city daily.

With the new plants, the treating capacity will go up to 110MLD. The official added that the new plants can be expanded to treat more water.

### Street clusters decline

In what may come as a relief to city residents fearing a third wave of Covid, street clusters in the city are continuing to reduce.

According to an official, the Corporation's early detection mechanism has paid off with no streets in the city having over 10 Covid cases at present.

Compared to last week when there were 25 streets with over five cases, 61 streets with over four cases, and 124 streets with three or more cases, it has now reduced to 20 streets with over five cases, 61 with over four cases, and 111 streets with three or more cases.

"Two of the major strategies that have helped the corporation control emerging clusters are repeated testing and sending almost all cases to facility quarantine instead of allowing home quarantine," the official said.

Teynampet Zone continues to lead with streets having the most active cases.

### Battery charging/swapping stations in fuel outlets

The first battery charging/swapping station for electric vehicles will come up in the Saidapet outlet of Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd. (HPCL) by year-end.

The company has tied up with the private company GoFuel for the project, with plans to commission 3,000 charging stations across the country in the next three years

Not stopping with drawing power to charge batteries, the fuel outlets will also have solar panels and any excess power generated will be given back to the grid. Apart from providing space in their outlets, HPCL will offer a subsidy of around Rs. 2 lakhs each to outlet owners to encourage them to go solar.

The charging time of a 25-30AH battery is about an hour and the charge will be around Rs. 400.

## Udavum Karangal reunites another patient with family

There was a call from a well-wisher of Udavum Karangal to Vidyaakar in August 2016 that a man, half naked, was loitering on the streets of Tirukovillur and creating trouble.

A. Mani, a social worker of Udavum Karangal in Tiruvannamalai, was immediately sent to rescue him. (Udavum Karangal maintains a Rehabilitation Home for the Destitute Mentally Ill in Tiruvannamalai). He was rescued on Aug. 25, 2016 in Thirukovillur and brought to the Home in Tiruvannamalai. His hair was matted and he was talking to himself. In the Home, his matted hair was removed and he was given a bath and a sumptuous meal. When asked his name he uttered words like Kumar. At the time he did not reveal any details about himself or his family. He never uttered a word about his whereabouts or his family for the past 5 years.

He was, therefore, referred to a psychiatrist who prescribed medication after which social workers started interacting with him. After repeated questioning for years, at last, in August this year, he opened up and uttered a few words like a place called Suthamalli, Tirunelveli where he had supposedly stayed earlier.

Our social worker Mani, an ex-serviceman (Ph: 9626123048), has some colleagues in Tirunelveli. He informed them of the place Suthamalli mentioned by the patient. In turn, they put his photo and name in the local Whatsapp group and circulated the news of 'missing and found'. On seeing the Whatsapp message, his brother Sankaranarayanan contacted Mani and said that Kumar was his brother and he would come to Tiruvannamalai to get him back.

A police complaint had also been lodged but there was no information. The brother said that Kumar alias Balu was a psychiatric patient for the past 10 years and the family could not give him treatment

due to poverty. So, his condition became worse and one day he left the house without informing anyone. Kumar has four sisters and a brother. One sister is a heart patient with psychiatric problems. Both the brothers are not married. His brother was very happy to learn that his brother, missing for 10 years, had been found. He came to Udavum Karangal on Sept. 18 and was reunited with him.

Vidyaakar said, "Our Social Worker Mani was quick in getting information about the patient's siblings and tracing his home. Such re-

unions are rare in the sense that when the parent of a patient is no more the siblings usually don't worry about their missing brother or sister. In this case, his elder brother was very happy and said that he would take care of him for life."

Udavum Karangal gave free medicines for a month as prescribed and he was also counseled on follow-up psychiatric treatment and regular medication.

Udavum Karangal has done more than 5000 such reunions during the last 37 years involving families of patients in 20 States," said Vidyaakar.

## Static teams monitoring crowding points

Chennai Corporation and the police have formed 123 static teams to monitor crowding and ensure adherence to standard operating procedures (SOPs) for Covid safety.

Of the 5,558 inspections conducted at marriage halls, at least 443 violations were found and a total fine of Rs. 8.1 lakhs was collected.

Meanwhile, Gagandeep

Singh Bedi and Commissioner of Police Shankar Jiwali conducted an awareness campaign on wearing of masks and other Covid norms on Sept. 18.

They made an on-the-spot assessment of compliance with rules as part of a special drive to enforce wearing of masks in public places such as markets, beaches and railway stations.

The two officials visited crowded areas such as Ranganathan Street in T. Nagar, Marina Beach and Central Railway Station and created awareness among shoppers, passengers and traders to prevent spread of Covid, stressing the need to prevent a third wave.

They interacted with traders in Ranganathan Street and urged them to follow all Covid norms while allowing customers inside their shops.

They distributed masks among beach-goers and made enquiries enquired about their vaccination status.

Near Central Railway Station, the two officials hopped onto a bus and spoke to passengers about maintenance of hygiene in public places and houses.

Jiwali told newsmen that on seeing slackness in wearing of masks, the officials decided to conduct a special drive for 10 days. "We expect an increase of at least 15% to 20% compliance in 10 days.
