Residents discuss stagnation problems

 Members of various resident associations in West Mambalam and Ashok Nagar gathered outside Ayodhya Mandapam (Arya Gowda Road, West Mambalam) on Nov. 24 to discuss ways to solve water stagnation problems in their areas.

They sent letters to the Corporation Commissioner and T. Nagar MLA seeking immediate steps to solve the problem.

Residents wanted heavy duty water pumps to be installed at Madley Road and Duraiswamy Road subways, which get flooded often, to drain out the water, Water coming mostly from Ashok Nagar area stagnates in the streets of West Mambalam. They wanted manholes cleaned at regular intervals to prevent sewage water contamination.

Areas under Smart City flooded after hour's rain

An hour's rain on Nov. 22 was enough to flood key stretches of T. Nagar where Smart City projects are in progress.

Despite drains being built under the missing link storm water drain project under Smart City Mission for Rs. 9.3 crores, most of G. N. Chetty Road, Prakasam Salai, South Usman Road, Burkit Road and other roads around Pandy Bazaar were under 3 feet of water.

While the Corporation blamed it on the blocks in drains and encroachment, many residents and social activists were of the view that it was the substandard quality of work done under the Smart City program and the inefficiency of the drain designs, plus non-maintenance of the existing drain network.

A resident of Habibullah Road said that the officials need to look at the reasons for the failure in planning under Smart City.

All roads off Habibullah Road are flooded. If they claim that this is a smart city, the planning should have been smarter, he said

Activist convenes meet on saving waterways

Corporation looks for new ways to curb waterlogging

Chennai Corporation has appointed six engineers to come up with solutions to prevent heavy waterlogging witnessed in six core spots in the city including G. N. Chetty Road and Bazullah Road in T. Nagar.

On G. N. Chetty Road, the Corporation has started checking for utilities blocking drains. In another move, 600mm Hume pipes were laid below road level to carry excess rainwater to Mambalam Canal from Bazullah Road, Vijayaraghava Road and G. N. Chetty Road on Nov. 24

An official told Mambalam Times that the pipes were laid on a war footing within 48 hours using JCPs and other heavy duty equipment.

Corporation officials are also looking at multiple disposal points for drains in such inundated locations as a long-term solution.

According to an official, in some areas in West Mambalam, it was found that waterlogging was caused as water from Ashok Nagar and Kodambakkam areas was drained into the Mambalam Canal instead of the canal in Trustpura that is connected to Cooum River.

Civic workers have tough time keeping subways open




Vehicles were using Duraiswamy Road subway according to late afternoon reports on Nov. 27.

Fearing water logging, residents park cars on flyovers

As waterlogging continues in several streets, the residents have started parking their vehicles on G. N. Chetty Road and Usman Road flyovers.

The residents say that even if it rains for an hour, they park their vehicles on the flyovers. Police said that some residents park their vehicles the previous night soon after checking the forecast. This has also slowed down the traffic on the stretch. "After the heavy rains during night on Nov. 10, my car got submerged when it was parked outside my house on Giri Road (T. Nagar). I spent almost Rs. 18,000 to repair it. Now I don't want to take any further risk, and park it at night on the flyover based on the weather prediction," Ramanujam said.

Another resident Balasubramanian from Sadasivam Street said "We cannot spend sleepless nights thinking about the rain and our car. I lost hope that the water will recede. Instead, it is better to park on the flyover". "The traffic police understand our concerns and do not object as long as it does not affect the traffic," he added.

Dengue cases on the rise

Since Nov. 17, 105 cases have been reported of which 18 are from Kodambakkam and 17 from Teynampet.
