Two held for assaulting girl

Two youths were arrested on March 30 for assaulting a girl in Guindy.

They were identified as B. Mukesh (22) of Saidapet and S. Syed Masood (23) of West Mambalam. They were produced before a judicial magistrate and sent to prison.

A police official said that an 18-year-old girl, who had come into contact with the prime accused Mukesh a few years ago, had filed a complaint. In her complaint, she said that she used to chat regularly with Mukesh but stopped responding to his calls over the mobile. Upset with this, Mukesh and his friend Syed Masood waylaid her when she was waiting at a bus stop. When she refused to talk, Mukesh hit the girl with his helmet and fled the spot.

Stray cattle impounded

Following frequent complaints from motorists about accidents caused by stray cattle, the Corporation has initiated action against the owners of about 20,000 animals in all the 15 zones of the city.

It has impounded 710 animals that strayed onto the road between March 1 and 25 of which 97 were from Kodambakkam Zone and 95 from Teynampet Zone.

The drive against stray cattle was intensified in the past few weeks.

Corporation officials have warned that owners will be penalised under the provisions of Section 11 of the Act.

The owners should get permission from the zonal officials to transport the animals from one place to another.

The animals that have been impounded for the third time will not be returned to the owners but handed over to the Blue Cross.

Block in sewage chamber cleared after report in Mambalam Times



Following the report 'Sewage water overflowing' published in Mambalam Times (March 20-26 issue), the block in the manhole chamber on Kavarai Street (West Mambalam) was cleared by Metrowater workers on March 24. The ditch which was dug to carry out repairs in the manhole chamber was closed with debris and blacktopped by Corporation workers. Sewage water had been overflowing and accumulating on the street for more than a month.

High Court dismisses plea against takeover of Ayodhya Mandapam

The Madras High Court has refused to interfere in the order issued by the Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments (HR and CE) Department appointing a "fit person" to take over administration of the Ayodhya Mandapam (Arya Gowda Road, West Mambalam).

Justice V. M. Velumani passed the order while dismissing a plea moved by Sri Ram Samaj challenging the order of the HR and CE department dated December 31, 2013.

The court refused to accept the Samaj's contention that it is not a public temple and therefore the department cannot interfere in its affairs.

According to the petitioner, the samaj is meant only for its members. The right of membership is not an automatic or vested right, neither is the right of entry to the premises.

"Large size pictures of Lord Rama, Lord Lakshmana, Sita and Hanuman are installed in



the samaj and poojas are done only for the pictures. No idols are kept and no poojas are conducted as per agama sastra. During the celebration of Sri Rama Navami, special prayers are performed for the pictures and annadhaanam is done on that day," the petitioner said.

Opposing the plea, the HR & CE Department argued that the Samaj is a public temple as per Section 6(20) of the Tamilnadu Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Act.

"In the Samaj, idols are kept and regular poojas are conducted and the public come to the temple to participate in poojas and worship therein. The petitioner receives money from devotees though hundial kept in the premises. The petitioner is not accounting for the amount received. A fit person was appointed in view of complaints received against the samaj," the HR & CE Department said.

Concurring with the submissions, the court dismissed the plea.

Skywalk project to be fast-tracked



The ongoing 'Skywalk Project' for pedestrians, Sept. 7, 2020 and was to be connecting T. Nagar bus terminus with Mambalam railway station, has been impacted by Covid lockdowns and functional delays. Even after resumption of work, the Rs. 23 crores project has been progressing at a slow pace.

Deputy Mayor Mahesh Kumar, after inspecting the construction of the bridge on March 15, directed the officials to fast-track the project.

The 'bhoomi pooja' for the

project was performed on Sept. 7, 2020 and was to be completed within 15 months.

An official told Mambalam Times that only 25% of the work has been completed till date and it might take another 15 to 18 months for the bridge to be ready at the current pace.

The Chennai Corporation is executing this project under the Smart City Mission.

He said that a total of 42 piles are being constructed and the delays are mainly due

to accessibility as the roads

are very congested and narrow. The 600-meter long and 4-metre wide skywalk is being constructed along Madley Road subway and Station Road. It will help passengers to reach the bus terminus and railway station avoiding crowded Usman Road and Ranganathan Street.

According to officials, around 50,000 persons use Ranganathan Street and Railway Border Road everyday to enter and exit the railway station. During festival seasons, the footfall rises to 1.5 lakhs, they said.

The bridge will also provide easy access to senior citizens and persons with disabilities.

An official stated that there will be ramps and tactile strips to help the visually challenged and pull-out ladders for escape in case of emergencies.

The family has been celebrating the 'miraculous' return of their pet dog Ruby, a 7-month-old female Golden Retriever, which went missing from a pet boarding centre on OMR on Feb. 14.

After Ruby went missing, the family did not lose hope and lodged police complaints and sought the social media platform for help to locate the dog. The CCTV footage obtained by the police on Feb. 19 had shown the dog roaming near a vehicle showroom and a Zomato delivery person playing with the dog and then carrying it away on his bike.

"We were finally able to track the food delivery partner at

the Navalur toll plaza. He informed us that he had given Ruby away to a friend in Mayiladuthurai and requested us to not reveal his identity and that he would bring Ruby back to our place. We told him that we would go and fetch her, instead. We immediately drove to Mayiladuthurai and returned to Chennai with Ruby, Deepu said. "It was indeed a tough time. Every alternate day, I was going from T. Nagar to Chemmenchery police station to check on the complaint lodged about my missing pet. Initially, I didn't receive much help from anyone. It was during this time that I saw a tweet by the Finance Minister of Tamilnadu, Palanivel Thiagarajan, in which he had

shared a picture with two of his pet dogs. I realised that he loved dogs, too. I tweeted to him saying that my pet had been missing for a long time. His team immediately plunged into action and began helping me with the search. The Tambaram Police Commissioner Dr. M. Ravi was alerted and soon, animal rights activists, too, got involved. "We could finally contact the food delivery agent and get back our pet with his help," she said.

Deepu met the Finance Minister on March 28 to thank him for his efforts.

She also thanked animal activists Shruti Vinodhraj, Antony Rubin and Saravanan Arasan for their help in locating the food delivery agent.

Help birds beat the heat

With temperatures soaring and hitting the 38 degree centigrade, environmentalists and nature lovers are doing their bit to help birds and animals this summer. Here's how you can join them:

Keeping water in bowls:

The water bowl attracts birds of all sizes and species. This will help not only the birds but also creatures such as squirrels.

Residents should keep bowls filled with fresh water in open places under shade such as terrace, balcony, garden or compound wall. The bowls should be refilled regularly.

You can also keep another bowl with millets or rice grains as they too attract birds.

This practice during summer will ensure that birds are not forced to move away from their habitat in search of water elsewhere. Statistics have proved that, when large numbers of birds leave an area due to scarcity of water, the weaker birds usually die.

It is better to opt for a shallow earthen bowl so that even smaller birds and mammals can drink from it. Avoid plastic and steel bowls as the water in them may get heated in the sun.

It may first take a couple of weeks for the birds to visit the bird bath. So be patient and keep refilling. It's best to leave the place undisturbed and observe for bird activity from a distance.

Clean the bowl periodically. If you are providing food, avoid cooked items like snacks and leftovers and only use raw grains. Native trees are the best hosts for birds. They rest on their branches, feed on the insects and worms on the bark and rest under their shade.

Metro rail work to link southern suburbs starts

If all goes according to plan, Chennai Metro will link several southern suburban localities, which are otherwise poorly linked to other parts of the city, by 2025.

Localities such as Madipakkam, Kovilambakkam, Medavakkam and Perumbakkam will benefit from the elevated corridor to come up on the 11.6 km. stretch between Puzhuthivakkam and Sholinganallur. The construction of the stretch commenced recently. It is part of the 47 km. corridor between Madhavaram and Sholinganallur. The 118.9 km. three-corridor phase-2 is expected to be completed by 2025.

Officials said that Hindustan Construction Company-KEC International JV, which was awarded the contract, recently started piling work at Kovilambakkam. The work involves laying the foundation for pillars that will support the elevated viaduct. Test piling in the stretch started towards the end of 2021. "We are pushing for the 2025 deadline in all our meetings," an official said.


Apart from the construction of the elevated line, 11 elevated stations will also be built on the stretch.

The stations will come up in Madipakkam, Kilkattalai, Echangadu, Kovilambakkam, Vellakkal, Medavakkam Koot Road, Kamaraj Garden Street, Medavakkam junction, Perumbakkam, Global Hospital and Elcot. The construction for the stretch carries a 36-month deadline. When the stretch is ready, residents in the southern suburban localities will be able to reach the airport, CMBT, Central or Egmore via Alandur metro, which will serve as a metro hub that links phase-1 and 2 corridors.

The residents will also be able to reach other localities like T. Nagar, Kodambakkam and the Lighthouse on Marina Beach by switching corridors at Porur junction. The stretch between Puzhuthivakkam and Sholinganallur will also serve as a link between the IT corridors in OMR and Porur as well as OMR and the airport and other transit points in the city.

Construction for phase-2 has commenced in areas like Porur, Poonamallee, Kodambakkam and Vadapalani, where main roads have been barricaded and traffic diversions have been introduced along a few stretches.

Garbage removed from canal dumped on road margin



Garbage that was removed from Mambalam Canal (North Road, West C.I.T. Nagar) a month back has been on the road margin. It is blocking 1/3rd of the carriageway. It is a health hazard to nearby residents.

Traffic police to take up repair of signals

The City Traffic Police will repair or replace traffic signals which are not functional, in two phases, within two months. Kapil Kumar Saratkar (Additional Commissioner of Police, Traffic) said that the traffic signals had remained switched off for nearly two years because of Covid and once traffic returned to normalcy from January, the process of renewal of Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) was initiated. 312 signals are under the purview of the city traffic police of which 46 signals are under repair and signals have been dismantled at 34 junctions for execution of infrastructure work.

A senior official said that some of the major signals which are need repair include the one at Mahalingapuram-South Usman Road junction. Similarly, signals have been dismantled at 34 junctions, including Anna Main Road-MGR Nagar junction in K. K. Nagar for stormwater drain work. Rs. 2 crores has been allotted from Road Safety Fund for the repairs.

In the first phase, 23 signals will be rectified for which a contract has been awarded and for the remaining 23 signals, tenders have been called for, he said.

110 auto drivers booked for fleecing

More than 110 autorickshaw drivers were booked by police on March 28 for fleecing stranded passengers across the city.

Since 90% of buses did not run, autos and taxis exploited the situation, and demanded two to three times the usual fare from passengers.

Surendar, a passenger at Chennai Central Railway Station, said that despite waiting for an hour, not a single bus was available to reach T. Nagar.

"Even share autos demanded more," he said.

Following complaints, a team headed by Additional Commissioner Kapil Kumar C. Saratkar monitored the fares at major transit hubs in the city, and booked 117 auto drivers.

New drains to have manholes 2 meters apart

Following heavy water logging following rains in several areas in the city including T. Nagar last November, Chennai Corporation has changed the design of the storm water drains. It has directed contractors to construct manholes every 2 meters apart instead of the existing 5-meter gap for effective desilting.

Despite the Corporation's directive, many contractors continue to flout the rule while constructing new storm water drains.

As Anna Main Road in K. K. Nagar was badly affected last

monsoon, the Corporation has commenced construction of new drains on the road.

But the two contractors assigned the work, are installing manholes 5 meters apart, said a local resident.

"Unless the manholes are closer, machine or manual cleaning will not be effective," he said.

S. Rajendiran (Chief Engineer, Chennai Corporation) said that action will be taken against contractors and local engineers if they fail to adhere to the design.

"We will not pay the contractors who fail to follow our design. All sites will be

inspected before releasing the bills. We'll rectify the error by using the money we retain. Also, memo will be served to local engineers for failing to ensure quality work," he said.

Meanwhile, the Corporation has issued work orders to construct new drains in roads in Royapuram, Teynampet, and Kodambakkam Zones at a total cost of Rs. 186 crore. Work has already commenced in some roads.

For the older drains, the civic body will remove the top portion of the drains if and when desilting work starts, and replace it with removable slabs for future desilting work.
