Couple in debt jump in front of moving train

A couple deep in debt ended their lives by jumping in front of a moving train at Mambalam Station on April 29.

Satish Kumar (41) and his wife Sasikala (39) lived in Karunguzhi near Madurantakam in Chengalpet district, police said.

The couple didnot have any children.

Satish Kumar ran a rice grinding unit in the village. During the lockdown, the couple struggled to make ends meet. They borrowed money from several sources but failed to repay their debts. Following this, the couple decided to end their lives.

They came to Mambalam railway station.

The couple jumped in front of the moving express train. The duo died on the spot.

Government railway police sent the bodies to the Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital for autopsy.

Two held for kidnapping, molesting 14-year-old girl

Ashok Nagar All Women Police arrested two men under the POCSO Act on the charge of molesting a 14-year-old girl after forcefully taking her into a house in West Mambalam.

The police said that the victim's mother was working as a domestic in a house in West Mambalam. She and her daughter went to the house on April 28 and at 3 p.m, she sent her daughter home for lunch. As the girl did not reach home, the woman came back. However, she heard the cries of her daughter from a nearby house and saw two men consuming alcohol outside the house.

On seeing the woman, the two men fled from the spot.

After the girl told her mother about the assault by the duo, she lodged a police complaint. The investigation revealed that the girl was forcefully taken and raped by the two men. They were identified as A. Selvam (30) and P. Karthikeyan (22).

Woman gets parents' death certificates 46 years after fatal crash

Nearly 46 years after her parents died in a plane crash in Mumbai, daughter Malini (a resident of West Mambalam) finally got their death certificate thanks to social activist V. Santhanam, Malini's father-in-law.

Malini lost her parents in the Indian Airlines plane crash on Oct.10, 1976, when she was just one and half years old.

Her parents, Parthasarathy and Vasanthi, were returning to Chennai from Mumbai after completing their holiday trip when the air crash happened.

Malini and her 3-year-old brother were left in their relative house in Chennai, when their parents went for the trip.

Later, Malini got married to Sridhar, son of the social activist Santhanam. A few years back, when she required the death certificates of her parents, it was found that no certificates were provided for the 95 persons who lost their lives in the crash. When Malini informed Santhanam, he contacted Mumbai municipal officials. As, there were no death certificates in the Mumbai municipal office, he contacted the airline office which effort was also fruitless. Santhanam then collected news articles and the list of passengers who had lost their lives in the flight crash from the internet. He even applied for a death certificate but the request was rejected by Mumbai municipal officials who said that the evidence was insufficient.

Then Santhanam, with the help of Mumbai-based social activist Shibu K. Gerge, filed a case in a Mumbai court and submitted a copy of the certificate which was issued in the T. Nagar cemetery in 1976. After hearings, the Mumbai court ordered the Municipality to issue death certificates. On April 29, certificates were handed over to Malini after the struggle of more than two years.

Nandanam traffic flow plan changes to ease congestion

In an attempt to ease congestion at Nandanam junction, Traffic Police have come up with yet another traffic diversion plan. Vehicles leaving T. Nagar take a 2-km detour to travel towards Saidapet. Earlier there was no option for motorists reaching the Nandanam signal via Venkatanarayana Road.

All Anna Salai bound vehicles from T. Nagar had to take the mandatory left on South Boag Road.

Now they can travel straight towards Nandanam signal, but have to take a left turn, drive 600 meters on Anna Salai to make a U-turn near Toyota showroom to reach Chamiers Road or Saidapet. The new traffic modifications are in place for 10 days from April 27 on a trial basis. Vehicles from Cenotaph Road going towards Teynampet have to take a left turn at the junction of Anna Salai and Cenotaph Road, proceed towards Saidapet for more than 250 meters and take a U-turn in front of Toyota showroom and proceed to their destination.

Vehicles from Bharathidasan Road going to Teynampet have to take a left turn at the junction of Anna Salai and Bharathidasan Road, proceed straight towards Saidapet for 300 meters and take a U-turn in front of Toyota showroom to reach their destination.



Metro ridership touched 45.46 lakhs in April

The ridership in Chennai Metro has seen a steady increase from 25.19 lakh passengers in January to 45.46 lakh passengers in April.

Chennai Metro has been offering a 20 per cent discount on QR code ticketing from November, 2020. An additional 20 per cent discount has been available on travel cards from February this year.

Mehendi, embroidery classes from May 16

Work to start on 2nd pipeline from Chembarambakkam treatment plant

Metrowater plans to resume work to lay the second pipeline to distribute water from the Chembarambakkam water treatment plant. This will facilitate conveying the maximum quantity of treated water to the city. Once the pipeline is fully laid, an additional 250 mld can be conveyed to the city within a year. Residents of areas, including West Mambalam, Saidapet, Koyambedu, Vadapalani and Mylapore, will receive better water supply. The water agency plans to approach the State Highways Department for permission to take up work on Poonamallee High Road and call for the tender. The water agency had started work in 2013 to lay a second water transmission pipeline from the facility in Chembarambakkam, which can treat up to 530 million liters a day (mld).

The Rs. 43.75-crore project aimed at laying the 2,000-mm diameter pipeline along Poonamallee High Road for a distance of 6.5 km from the plant to Poonamallee bypass junction near Maduravoyal.

Work had been pending on a nearly 530-meter stretch on Poonamallee High Road as its course was near the incomplete pillars of the Chennai Port-Maduravoyal Elevated Corridor.

The contract was cancelled in March 2019 due to a delay in the project, and the wait for permission from the National Highways Authority of India also led to a suspension in the project. The second pipeline from Chembarambakkam plant will be linked to the existing infrastructure near the Koyambedu grade separator. This will enable supply to the central and southern areas and even to certain northern parts of the city.

Since its inception in 2007, the Chembarambakkam plant had not been operated to its full capacity even when the reservoir had ample resources. This was due to lack of an adequate distribution network.

At present, only about 260 mld is being treated and supplied through the pipeline to Porur from where it reaches some central and southern areas.

Nine 5KWp of solar plants have been provided in office, service and station buildings in Chennai division.



252 toilet lounges to be built

Chennai Corporation is all set to build new toilet lounges in Royapuram, Thiru Vi Ka Nagar and Teynampet Zones on a pilot basis.

According to a Corporation document, 252 toilet lounges will be constructed at a cost of Rs. 268 crores under the public-private partnership (PPP) method.

"The construction firms will not be allowed to collect user charges from the public, but they can generate revenue from ads, and providing other facilities like ATMs, sanitary napkin dispenser and other utilities," an official said.

"A request for proposal will be floated inviting firms to take up the project," he added.

The Corporation has already started construction of toilets for women at a cost of Rs. 33 crores under the Nirbhaya Fund.

Tenders have also been floated to construct and upgrade more than 150 conventional toilets across the city including those built for persons with disabilities.

Autos parked outside mall cause traffic jam



After 10 surgeries last year, girl appears for board exams

Eight lakh students are taking the Std. 12 board exams in person this year after a gap of two years.

Among them is S. Sindhu of T. Nagar who, despite undergoing 10 surgeries last year, is appearing for the exams.

She is a commerce student in Vidhyodaya Girls Higher Secondary School (T. Nagar).

Due to her health condition, Sindhu has got permission to write the exam lying on a cot and with help from a scribe.

She fell from the third floor of a building in December 2020 that left her bedridden. As the surgery on her right leg was botched up, despite several operations she still has an open wound and cannot walk.

The district level volleyball player now needs assistance to sit. The fall cost the 17-year-old all her teeth. She had to undergo extensive reconstructive surgery.

The pandemic forced the world to adapt to new realities. The girl who, dreamt of joining the Army, has adapted to hers too. "I wanted to become a professional volleyball player and my aim was to join the army," Sindhu said.

"Though joining the army is ruled out, I still hope to pursue volleyball if I am able to walk again", she said.

She lives in a rented single-room house with her parents and younger brother. Her father S. Shakti is a tea seller and her mother Devi is a housewife.

"Our daughter is resilient and the consequences of the accident have not deterred her determination to succeed in life. She is hard working and keeps a positive outlook to life", Shakti said.

Her teachers and a relative have been very helpful. They take turns to visit the bedridden Sindhu to help her prepare for her exams and clarify any doubts she has after listening to recordings of the classes that she gets on WhatsApp.

She attended practical exams last week assisted by her parents. Sindhu donated her hair for cancer patients a few days before her accident.

She was interested in voluntary services.

The whole school observed a mass prayer recently for Sindhu and the teachers pooled Rs. 50,000 for her treatment when she was in hospital.

Due to the war between Russia and Ukraine, the price of 22-carat gold, which had crossed Rs. 40,000 in previous weeks, fell to Rs. 38,000 on May 3.

Septuagenarian sets up community shelf

70-year-old R.B. Balasubramaniam has installed a shelf in front of his small shop in T. Nagar.

The almirah is for anyone to deposit anything that they no longer needed: clothes, utensils, toys etc. These items were left there for the needy to pick up free.

He said the initiative was started after his son was laid off from work because of the Covid lockdown.

"We decided to open a tea and snacks shop with four major concepts. 'Udavumullangal', the fourth concept, is about starting a community initiative.

Slowly, people started to respond. Initially, they deposited toys, then saris, masks, T-shirts etc. People always drop by and pick up what they need, free of cost. I clean the rack every day and make sure that it is easily accessible to everybody."



The growth of Chai Kings from 1 to 40 outlets

Chai Kings was launched by Jahabar and Balaji in Kilpauk in October 2016.

In December that year, three more, in Mount Road, Anna Nagar and T. Nagar, were added.

According to Jahabar (one of the promoters), the introduction of meal delivery partners such as Swiggy and Zomato boosted their business significantly.

"We initially made Rs. 500 each day, and then it grew to Rs 10,000. Our cardboard flasks were reasonably priced and, with the help of Swiggy and Zomato, sales began to increase," he said. In the last 5 years, in spite of lockdowns, they have managed to open 40 outlets in the city. Jahabar and Balaji said that their main advantage is the price of their 'chai', which is Rs. 20. 'Food accounts for 45 percent of our expenses. Another 20% is set aside for wages, and the remaining 18% is set aside for rent'.

The presently earn Rs. 10 lakhs to 12 lakhs per store per month of which 40% is through online orders. "At present, Chai Kings sells about 25,000 cups of tea per day, with ginger chai taking the top spot", Balaji said.

They started a store last month in Coimbatore, which is their 1st outside Chennai.

Act on senior citizens' pleas in 90 days, HC tells government

The Madras High Court has directed the Tamil Nadu government to redress or give a solution within 90 days on the complaint petitions filed by senior citizens.

The court also noted that if action was not taken within 90 days, the revenue divisional officer will be held responsible for the delay.

Justice Anita Sumanth passed the direction on hearing a petition filed by N. Sada-sivam, a 66-year-old resident from Kodungaiyur, Chennai.

The petitioner sought a direction to the Chennai district collector under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 to take action against the former's son for harassing him to get property documents.

When the matter came up for hearing, the judge directed the state government to file a counter explaining how many petitions from senior citizens were pending with the authorities across the state.

Additional Advocate General J. Ravindran submitted that 292 petitions are pending in various revenue divisions across the state. On recording the submissions, the judge directed the state government to resolve petitions filed by senior citizens within 90 days. If not done, the RDOs concerned would be held responsible for the lapse.

Sewage lines to stormwater drains sealed

Chennai Corporation has launched a major drive to seal illegal sewage connections to stormwater drains. Metro-water officials will visit localities and provide proper sewer connections for buildings.

About 500 buildings with illegal sewage connections to stormwater drains have been identified and 303 of them have been plugged.

They include 78 buildings with illegal sewage connections in Teynampet Zone, the highest so far in the city. The number is expected to increase significantly. According to estimates, more than 30% of the existing stormwater drains have illegal sewage connections.

In the first phase, all assistant engineers will facilitate sewage connections for 2,000 houses after identifying and plugging the illegal sewage connections. All houses and shops with illegal sewage connections will be identified in a month.

Corporation Commissioner Gagandeep Singh Bedi has directed all assistant engineers to advise residents to approach Metrowater officials and get a proper sewer connection within 30 days.

"Information at toll free number 1913 will be valuable," Bedi said. Most of the identified residents have paid a fine of Rs. 5,000.

Residents have been warned that the Corporation will take penal action against the owners of buildings as per Section 202 (5) of the Chennai City Municipal Corporation Act, 1919.
