The play 'Charukesi' captures the travails of a musician

United Amateur Artistes' (UAA) staged the Tamil play 'Charukesi' in Sri Thyaga Brahma Gana Sabha (T. Nagar) on May 14.

The script is about a successful musician named Charukesi whose life gets affected by Alzheimer's.

Melodious music that played in the background set the tone for the play, named after a Carnatic raga.

The play, written by Venkat, has been directed by Y. Gee. Mahendra. The title role has been enacted by Mahendra.

Tough guidelines to rein in builders flouting norms

With the local bodies including Chennai Corporation lacking established guidelines to take action against unauthorised construction and building plan violations, the State Housing and Urban Development Department has commenced a process to frame guidelines for the local bodies. An official said that there is a set of guidelines for Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority (CMDA) based on which the planning authority acts against the unauthorised and buildings constructed in violation of rules. The guidelines have been framed based on Tamilnadu Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 to streamline the measures against illegal construction. Meanwhile, Chennai Corporation has intensified checks against building plan violations since January. It issued planning permission approvals for 2,705 buildings between January 1 and April 30. After issuing the planning permission approvals, the civic body has instructed local engineers to inspect the buildings at the plinth level for violations.

During the inspections, the civic body identified more than 500 buildings being constructed by contravening the approved plan. Of the identified buildings, stop-work notices have been issued on 467 buildings, while lock and seal notices have been issued in respect of 66 buildings. "We have instructed the building owners to place boards showing details such as approved plan, setback area, floors and other details. Also, applicants who are waiting for plan approval for more than 30 days can approach us directly," said Gagandeep Singh Bedi, Chennai Corporation Commissioner.

Chennai Metro seeks NoC from Water Resources Department for Phase II project

Chennai Metro has sought a no-objection certificate (NoC) from the Water Resources Department (WRD) for its Phase II project that runs along waterbodies and waterways in the city.

A tunnel in Corridor 3 of the Madhavaram-Sipcot stretch would clash with the pile foundation of Buckingham Canal bridge at Mylapore.

Chennai Metro proposes to demolish the culvert close to Thirumayilai MRTS station and then rebuild it later.

At one of the stations near in Porur, a pillar has to be raised close to the lake.

"Between Kodambakkam and Poonamallee, it will be an elevated stretch. Close to the bund of the Porur lake, a pillar will be raised for the viaduct. Though the waterbody will not be affected, we will still need an approval from the WRD," an official said. The WRD has received proposals to permit piers inside the waterbody near Nandanam as the station diaphragm would infringe on the tank bund canal.

The official said that more permissions would be sought at various levels of the project implementation.

Skywalk to be inaugurated next month

T. Nagar Skywalk, which will connect Mambalam railway station with T. Nagar bus terminus, is set to be inaugurated next month after a delay of over a year.

The Rs. 27-crore project under Smart City Mission began in December 2020 and was supposed to be completed in 15 months.

The skywalk is 600 meters long and about 4 meters wide.

Battery-operated vehicles will be provided for aged and disabled persons.

The infrastructure will include a lift near the bus terminus and an escalator near the railway station.

It is provided with LED lights, solar panels, CCTVs, signboards, fire extinguishers, ladders, dustbins, flower pots and rainwater harvesting systems.

It will help reduce congestion

on crowded Usman Road and Ranganathan Street.

More than 50000 persons use the railway station every day and they can avoid the crowded streets by using the skywalk.

Steps will be taken to ensure the skywalk is not taken over by hawkers. Pending dues from contractors, Covid lockdowns and various other design interventions led to the delay in the project, an official said.
