

Traffic diversion near Nandanam junction to stay

The traffic diversion near Nandanam junction, which was introduced on April 28, will be a permanent arrangement from June 18.

Vehicles from Venkatanarayana Road and going to Chamiers Road should turn left and enter Anna Salai, proceed to Teynampet for 200m and take a U-turn in front of the Toyota showroom.

Vehicles from Cenotaph Road and going to Teynampet should turn left and enter Anna Salai, proceed towards Saidapet for 250m and take a U-turn in front of the Toyota showroom.

Vehicles from Bharathidasan Road going to Teynampet should turn left and enter Anna Salai, proceed towards Saidapet for 300m and take a U-turn in front of the Toyota showroom.

Meanwhile, the city traffic police also said the diversions introduced near Dasaprakashjunction, Chetpet junction and Kasi cinema point last April will continue since they helped ease congestion.

Rise in Covid cases due to residential clusters

The latest rise in Covid cases in the city is in residential clusters and more than 90% of the cases are from inside the city, health minister Ma Subramanian said on June 15. The city has 984 active cases, out of which about 50% are from core city areas such as Anna Nagar, Teynampet, Kodambakkam, Adyar and Valsaravakkam.

"The previous clusters were in educational institutions like IIT Madras, Anna University, VIT, Sathya Sai Institute and Rajiv Gandhi Institute. Cases in the institutes have largely decreased," he said, after a Covid review meeting in Ripon Buildings.

The minister said there are 46 streets in Chennai with more than three cases each while six streets have five or more cases.

"Only 51 persons are in hospitals and have comorbidities. All the cases are mild. The Corporation staff are constantly in communication with the affected persons and every day, an oxygen saturation test is done for the home-isolated patients," he added. The city will also have three Covidcare centres, one each in north, south and central areas of the city.

The minister added that only 40% of the people have taken their precautionary dose of Covid vaccine.

"People must not wait for mega vaccination camps. They can take the shots any day in the health centres," he said. The minister said they are pasting caution stickers on positive patients' houses to ensure others do not come in contact with them. Corporation Commissioner Gagandeep Singh Bedi said they have increased contact tracing again to isolate patients early and have asked zonal officers to ensure daily phone monitoring. Doctors have also advised people to take the booster dose.

Why not generic form of medicines?

Sir, People cannot do without certain essential items like food, conveyance, medicines etc. but the cost of consumable items is hitting the roof everyday. The cost of medicines manufactured by private companies is almost five times higher than that of the generic equivalent.

For example, one strip of Glycomet- GP 1 containing 15 tablets costs Rs. 116.50 whereas one strip of the generic equivalent containing 10 tablets costs Rs. 16.

Doctors generally prescribe company products the cost of which is beyond the reach of not only the common man but also people like pensioners and low wage earners. Either the doctors should prescribe the generic medicines or the prescription should contain a statutory guideline that "equivalent generic medicines may also be used". Labourers cleaning drains not provided safety gear

A group of 10 labourers engaged by a Chennai Corporation contractor were seen de-silting a storm water drain in Bazullah Road (T. Nagar) on June 15 without wearing any protective gear.

After the video taken by a resident went viral on social media, a Corporation official clarified that it has lodged a police complaint against the contractor who did not provide safety gear for workers desilting drains in T. Nagar. The workers wore no gloves, rubber boots or masks while cleaning the drain pits to clear blockages.

The official said the contractor had been told to follow safety precautions, but he did not comply with the norms.

SafaiKaramchariAndolan (a movement for elimination of manual scavenging) said that their organisation had met all district officials and had petitioned the officials to ensure workers were provided safety gears.

Murder accused who was absconding for 20 years arrested

The Pondy Bazaar police have arrested Ramakrishnan, an accused who was reported absconding for 20 years after allegedly murdering a Siddha doctor in T. Nagar in 2002 and taking away jewellery and cash from her house.

The police said A. Malarkodi (67), a Siddha practitioner, had been estranged from her husband and was living with her brother A. Anandakumar (70), also a Siddha practitioner.

Both were running a clinic in their house on Raghaviah Road (T. Nagar).

On May 21, 2002, she was found dead. Her brother was attacked and incapacitated. He managed to raise an alarm and neighbours came to his rescue. Based on a complaint by Anandakumar, Pondy Bazaar police registered a case and took up investigation. Five sovereigns of gold jewellery and Rs. 1 lakh cash were missing from the house. Investigation revealed that R. Alagarsamy (22), who worked as a domestic servant for the siblings, and his accomplice Ramakrishnan had committed the crime. While Sakthivel was arrested, Ramakrishnan had gone missing.

His whereabouts were not known to his family for 15 years since he was hiding in Kerala and working in a private firm.

Five years back, Ramakrishnan's brother came to know that he was working in a knitting firm in Tiruppur and advised him to shift to his native village.

Meanwhile, I. Sivakumar, Inspector (Pondy Bazaar) launched a fresh investigation and traced Ramakrishnan to his native village of Kollampatti in Dindigul district.

He was arrested and remanded to judicial custody.

Corporation to build modern toilets

Chennai Corporation will build modern toilet lounges at an estimated cost of Rs.221 crores in various parts of the city under public-private partnership.

Corporation Commissioner Gagandeep Singh Bedi said the civic agency had called for national bids for design, build, operate and transfer of toilet lounges for an eight-year period under Swachh Bharat Mission 2.0, with public-private partnership.

The facilities will be of two categories, new constructions and retrofitting and remodelling of existing public toilets.

The private agencies will come up with their own modern innovative designs to make the facilities world class, with kiosks and space for vending.

Teynampet Zone will get toilet lounges at 11 locations.


The contractor will be permitted to earn revenue using innovative methods such as advertisement, commercial retail spaces for legally approved products and services.

However, the services for residents will be free and the Corporation will form a committee to examine the revenue streams proposed by the contractors before commencement of the project.

The toilet lounges will have maintenance staff round the clock with improved access to women, children, senior citizens and persons with disabilities.

The toilet lounges will adopt digital technologies, sensors and automation for effective maintenance.

According to an official, around 7,000 parking spaces have been created in 83 locations and a private firm has been appointed to manage the parking spaces. The charges are Rs. 20 per hour for cars and Rs. 5 per hour for 2-wheelers.

Boards have been placed at every 25 meters to apprise owners of the parking management system.

Facial recognition system launched for civic workers

Chennai Corporation has launched a biometric facial recognition system in 315 locations to monitor the attendance of conservancy workers for improved solid waste management and delivery of various services.

The Corporation has 14,857 employees for implementing civic infrastructure projects, distribution under welfare schemes and delivery of services in the 15 zones of the city.

9,046 permanent workers for conservancy and labourers for road repair are also employed in Tondiarpet, Royapuram, Thiru Vi Ka Nagar, Anna Nagar and parts of Ambattur.

Conservancy operator Urbaser Sumeet has deployed 10,839 workers for solid waste management in Teynampet, Kodambakkam, Valasaravakkam, Alandur, Adyar, Perungudi and Sholinganallur.

Another private conservancy operator Chennai Enviro Private Limited has deployed 3,220 workers for solid waste collection, transportation and disposal in Tiruvottiyur, Manali and Madhavaram.

The private conservancy operators have installed biometric attendance recording system for employees to register attendance twice every day.

Face recognition system has also been installed for civic workers in Ripon Buildings, three regional offices, 15 zonal offices, 47 unit offices and 200 ward offices and at various other locations to monitor attendance.

Four sewage treatment plants getting ready

Chennai will have four more sewage treatment facilities in a few months along the city's major waterways.

Work to build modular sewage treatment plants in three locations along the Adyar and the Cooum and tertiary treatment ultrafiltration plant at Langs Garden are nearing completion.

The modular STP in Chetpet was inaugurated last month.

Metrowater is building modular STPs with a total capacity to treat 4 million litres daily at the Todhunter Nagar sewage pumping station near Mambalam canal in Saidapet. According to officials, it would be ready by September.

Two modular STPs, taken up at an estimate of Rs.4.31 crores, on the right bank of



the Adyar near Kotturpuram will be ready by July. The two plants would have a combined capacity to treat six lakh litres of sewage daily, officials said. Officials said once the modular STPs and laying of pipelines are completed,

nearly 39 sewage outfalls into Adyar River would be plugged.

A similar project is being executed in Nandanam Extension, Turn Bulls Road, Samiyar Thottam and Jaffer Khanpet to mitigate the pollution of waterways.

Drones to scan buildings for fire safety



The Special Task Force, constituted more than three years ago to crackdown on illegal buildings across the city, will use drones to review 149 buildings which are under the scanner for violation of fire safety norms. A consultant will be hired by the Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority (CMDA), after which inspection will be carried out.

This comes after a separate study on fire safety measures with an alternative mechanism in congested areas like George Town, Purasawalkam, Triplicane and T. Nagar.

"We wanted to have scientific data on these buildings. Doing it manually will take time," a senior official said.

Fire consultant V. Sivaramakrishnan said that drones cannot find out whether the sprinklers are working or are connected to the water pump. This has to be done manually.

According to a survey of 150 multi-storied buildings in T. Nagar carried out by the State Fire and Rescue Services Department, it was found that in most buildings, water storage and provision of fire pump facilities and hydrant systems are not as per requirements of the National Building Code.

Most buildings also do not have automatic sprinkler systems.

CPR awareness drive in metro stations

Chennai Metro conducted a free Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) awareness program in Shenoy Nagar and Kilpauk metro stations last week in association with TACT Academy for Clinical Training (Anna Nagar). Collection wells in subways to be desilted

Disabled-friendly facilities in metro stations soon

Chennai Metro on June 15 informed the Madras High Court that it will take steps to provide facilities to aid differently-abled passengers and approachable physical structures within six weeks in all its stations.

It made this submission before the first bench of Chief Justice Munishwar Nath Bhandari and Justice N. Mala while hearing a plea filed by Vaishnavi Jayakumar, an activist working for the welfare of the physically challenged. The petitioner had submitted that the metro stations do not comply with mandatory accessibility standards under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act and Rules.

The petitioner further submitted that the Union Ministry of Urban Development issued detailed guidelines for designing buildings for disabled-friendly persons and ensuring universal access but they had been violated by Chennai Metro.

On recording the submissions, the bench adjourned the matter for six weeks.

Help birds beat the heat

With temperatures soaring and hitting the 41-degree centigrade mark, environmentalists and nature lovers are doing their bit to help birds and animals this summer. Here's how you can join the bandwagon.

Keeping water in bowls:

The water bowl attracts birds of all sizes and species. This will help not only the birds but also creatures such as squirrels.

Residents should keep bowls filled with fresh water in open places with shade in their houses or flats such as terrace, balcony, garden or compound wall. The bowls should be refilled regularly. You can also keep another bowl with millets or rice grains as they too attract birds.

This practice during summer will ensure that birds are not forced to move away from their habitat in search of water elsewhere. Statistics have proved that when large numbers of birds leave an area due to scarcity of water, the weaker birds usually die.

It is better to opt for a shallow earthen bowl so that even smaller birds and mammals can drink from it. Avoid plastic and steel bowls as the water may get heated in the sun.

It may take a couple of weeks for the birds to visit the bird bath. So be patient and keep refilling. It's best to leave the place undisturbed and observe for bird activity from a distance. Clean the bowl periodically. If you are providing food, avoid cooked items like snacks and leftovers and only use raw grains. Native trees are the best hosts for birds. They rest on their branches, feed on the insects and worms on the bark and rest under their shade.

The animal activist group People For Cattle in India (PFCI) (Raghavaiah Road, T. Nagar) has kicked off its annual 'Water Bowl Challenge' by appealing to people to click and upload photos of animals/birds drinking out of bowls in their Facebook page to inspire participation.

G. Arun Prasanna (Member, PFCI) told *Mambalam Times* that every year, thousands of animals and birds die due to dehydration as they do not have access to clean drinking water. Parents fret about reopening of schools amid spike in Covid cases

"It is impossible to stop kids from interacting with each other and sharing food. It has been a couple of years since the students had gone to school and excitement is high. Different break timings for each class could help control this," said a parent.

School education authorities said there will not be any change in school reopening dates.

Dry weather decreases air pollution levels

Though vehicle movement in the city remained the same, the air pollution level has improved following a spell of dry weather this month.

On June 14, the PM 2.5 level recorded in Alandur was 59 microgram/m³, Kodungaiyur (51), Manali (47), Velachery (45), Arumbakkam (42), Royapuram (26) and Perungudi (20). The pollution levels had gone above the permissible limit of 60 microgram/m³ in May following a change in wind condition.

Rs. 4.85 lakhs penalty collected from cattle owners

Work on storm water drain stalled in Raghaviah Road

After much fanfare, storm water drain expansion work was started in several areas in T. Nagar and West Mambalam, but there has been no progress in some areas like Raghaviah Road (T. Nagar) outside the Corporation complex after a trench was dug last month.

The open trench is now unsafe for both pedestrians and motorists.

Debris of the existing drain which was broken has been dumped in the trench.

Nearby residents had to suffer due to water inundation during the heavy rains last November.

N. Veerappan (a nearby resident) told this reporter that they were initially happy that the Corporation had begun to widen the drain last month. "But now, with the existing drain demolished and no progress, we are worried if



the work will be completed before the monsoon," he said.

"Reports published in dailies state that the Corporation Commissioner and even the Chief Minister and local councillors are conducting regular inspections of the civic works, but on our street the situation is the reverse.
