Garbage woes on Mambalam High Road



Six garbage bins have been placed on Mambalam High Road, near its junction with Ramachandran Street (T. Nagar) into which garbage collected from various streets is dumped daily. This is creating an unhygienic environment which is a health hazard to passersby and nearby residents. Often, the bins overflow. Stray cattle and dogs rummage through the waste looking for food and strew it all around the place. The bins are occupying 1/3rd of the carriageway, which obstructs free flow of traffic.

The residents have appealed to officers of Chennai Corporation to keep only one or two bins at the spot and relocate the rest to prevent the present unhygienic condition.

Sewage water overflowing on Ramarao Street

Sewage water has been overflowing from a manhole chamber and accumulating on a long stretch of Ramarao Street (adjacent to the Corporation playground, T. Nagar). A nearby resident told this reporter that sewage water has been overflowing for more than a week and no action has been taken in spite of several complaints to the local Metrowater office. Nearby residents, motorists and pedestrians are put to hardship. It is also a severe health hazard.



Corporation issues stop-work notices for building rules violation

Cracking down on violators, Chennai Corporation has issued 704 stop-work notices for under-construction buildings where officials found deviations from original plans.

In addition to issuing notices, the civic body has also charged three officials, including a zonal officer from north Chennai, for failing to enforce norms. According to construction norms, if a stop-work notice is issued and the violator still continues construction, the assistant executive engineer concerned should be charged.

Officials from eight zones including Kodambakkam and Teyampet have been pulled up for poor performance on issuing lock-and-seal notices. Corporation Commissioner Gagandeep Singh Bedi said that lately, there were numerous cases of plans being approved on paper but actually there is a deviation.

"As a start, we are checking with permissions given in the last six months and cracking down on them. Assistant Engineers must carry out field visits and inspect newer constructions at the plinth level," he said.

In a recent circular, the Corporation has asked its zonal engineers to ensure that the building plan is displayed on a board at the entrance of all the new construction sites.

Govt. promises temple structures will not be affected by metro work

The State Government on June 21 assured the Madras High Court that the phase -II works of Chennai Metro in Corridor 4 between Lighthouse and Poonamallee will not affect the decades-old temples. The State Government's Advocate General R. Shunmugasundaram made this submission before the first bench of Chief Justice Munishwar Nath Bhandari and Justice N. Mala.

He submitted that the works are being carried out only in the commercial lands belonging to the temples. The bench was hearing a plea filed by activists seeking directions to restrain Chennai Metro from implementing the works in Corridor-4. The temples include Murugan Temple, Vengeeswarar Temple and Alagar Perumal Temple in Vadapalani.

Recording the assurance of the state government, the bench disposed of the matter.

After crash death, weak trees being identified

Following the death of a 57-year-old woman on Laksmanasamy Salai (KK Nagar) when a tree fell on her car, Corporation officials issued instructions to its field workers to identify weak trees and tie them to abutting stormwater drains to reduce their weight.

In a circular to engineers in the zone, Corporation Commissioner Gagandeep Singh reiterated that continuous steel barricading should be provided from the time work begins till covering slabs are laid on stormwater drains.

The engineers were also told to avoid using red tape between barricades, and penalise contractors if lapses

are found. Wherever steel barricades are not placed, casuarina poles are to be used temporarily. Reflective stickers must be pasted on barricades at all important turnings to improve night-time visibility, the circular said, adding that warning boards should be placed at all sites.

The deceased, Vani Kabilan, was a resident of Porur and working as manager in Indian Overseas Bank (KK Nagar branch).

A senior official said that there was a gap of 10 feet between the tree and storm water drain work site.

He said a detailed enquiry by the Deputy Commissioner (works) and Regional Deputy Commissioner (central region) was ordered on the day the accident took place and the work has been stopped.

Special squads remove encroachments, illegal sewer connections

Zonal squads that were constituted by Chennai Corporation to take action against encroachments and illegal sewer connections have removed more than 500 encroachments across the city.

According to a Chennai Corporation press release, encroachments at 528 places across the city have been removed and 94 illegal sewer connections linked to stormwater drains cut since the squads were formed.

Apart from this, 406.64 tonnes of construction waste were removed.

Chennai Corporation Commissioner Gagandeep Singh Bedi issued an order to form inter-departmental zonal squads for the removal of encroachments, clearing of debris and plugging of illegal sewer connections in all the 15 zones.

The squads work in coordination with the police department and traffic wing and others. Each squad is composed of an assistant executive engineer, an assistant or junior engineer, an additional divisional engineer, 10 road workers and 5 malaria workers.

The squads inspect all the arterial roads and commercial areas in their respective zones for removal of encroachments, clearing of debris, and plugging of illegal sewer connections on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays of every week.

Corporation officials have asked residents to themselves remove encroachments and illegal sewer connections as the zonal squads will impose penalties.

Corporation launches encroachment removal drive



Chennai Corporation has launched a major drive against encroachments and has so far removed 274 illegal structures on roads, footpaths, playgrounds and public spaces maintained by the civic body in the last week.

They include encroachments in various zones of the city including those along major stretches like Usman

Road and 2nd Avenue, Ashok Nagar. 46 encroachments in Teynampet Zone and 38 in Kodambakkam Zone were removed.

After the Corporation asked residents to complain about encroachments on the 1913 helpline, it has started receiving complaints about encroachments in the zonal offices as well.

T. Nagar resident V.S. Jayaraman said the Corporation should remove encroachments on Ranganathan Street.

“Residents are unable to walk on streets because of encroachments. Service roads of Usman Road are not used by vehicles because of encroachments. T. Nagar is again becoming an area with

many encroachments. The Corporation should continue the drive,” he said.

Corporation Commissioner Gagandeep Singh Bedi said encroachment removal would be done continuously. “The encroachment removal drive for three days a week will continue based on the feedback the zonal officers get at the local level,” he said.

Active Covid cases cross 3,000

From 188 active cases on May 24, the number of active cases rose to 3,106 on June 26, a 16-fold increase.

The highest number of cases have been reported in Kodambakkam, Teynampet and Adyar zones.

In Valasaravakkam zone, the caseload has increased from 2 to 222 during the period.

A total of 165 streets in the city have more than three Covid cases and, of them, 30 streets have more than six positive cases.

Overall, 1,500 streets have positive cases.

The daily case load is nearing 500 as 497 new cases were reported on June 26.

Health minister Ma Subramanian said nearly 92% of the patients are in home-isolation and those in hospitals too are only having cold, cough, fever and mild infection. “None of the admitted patients require ICU treatment or oxygen support,” he said.

The minister said that the Omicron BA4 and BA5 variants are spreading faster and if one person from a family is affected, the others too are infected immediately. “Thus, the family members must take precautions and wear masks. People must come forward to take the remaining vaccine doses too,” he said.

Chennai Corporation has intensified contact tracing of close and extended family members.

Officials said that nearly 12 lakh persons in the city are yet to get their second dose of vaccination. “We have asked health officials to do door-to-door vaccination and increase awareness in the 60 plus group for the third dose,” the official said.

Schools and colleges have been asked to cover 100% vaccination.

IAS officers to monitor storm water drain work

According to an order issued by Chief Secretary Irai Anbu, the officers must oversee completion of short-term flood-mitigation projects without causing hardship to residents and motorists.



On-street parking fee hiked on Thyagaraya Road

In an effort to promote the multilevel parking facility installed by Chennai Corporation on Sir Theagaraya Road (between Thanikachalam Road and Singaravelar Street, T. Nagar), it has increased on-street parking charges for cars and two-wheelers.

The revised fees are Rs. 15 per hour for two-wheelers and Rs. 60 per hour for four-wheelers, against Rs. 5 and Rs. 20 respectively charged

earlier.

There is no hike in the fee for parking in the multilevel parking facility.

The facility, which was constructed at a cost of Rs 40 crores with a capacity to accommodate 222 cars and 513 two-wheelers, was inaugurated last February.

But in spite of creating awareness, shoppers continued to prefer on-street parking, thereby leading to congestion and defeating the

very purpose of creating the facility.

A Corporation official told *Mambalam Times* that in May the collection was only Rs 1.16 lakhs.

With the revision of charges, one side of the Pedestrian Plaza is to be notified as 'No Parking.'

The 6-floor facility, developed under the Smart City plan in an area of 8,826 sq m, has robotic multilevel parking with minimal human

intervention.

It can accommodate all types of cars up to 5.1 meters long including the larger SUVs.

Valet facility, visitors' lounge, room for drivers, restrooms, and baby feeding area are some of the facilities available.

The parking fee is Rs. 20 per hour for cars and Rs. 5 per hour for two-wheelers.

Parking is permitted only through GCC Smart Parking App.

Street not relaid after Metrowater work

Sewage pipes, cables damaged during work on drain project

Chennai Corporation started storm water drain projects two weeks back at a cost of Rs. 900 crores in flood-prone areas of the city including T. Nagar, Ashok Nagar and KK Nagar.

Since the work started, several complaints about damaged sewage pipelines, telephone and internet lines, and underground electric cables have been reported by residents. N. Murli (an IT professional and resident of 2nd Avenue, Ashok Nagar), who has been working from home for the past 3 years, said that his work was hampered for a week due to disruption of internet connection in his area.

He said that the storm water drain project contractors are not careful while digging trenches with earthmovers and damage the underground utilities like power and fiber optic cables. Rains made the situation worse, leaving several stretches non-motorable.

Contractors did not clear the sewage-contaminated water stagnating on the roads, a resident said.

Man gets life imprisonment under POCSO Act

A special court for exclusive trial of cases under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act convicted and sentenced a 43-year-old man (a resident of T. Nagar) for repeatedly raping his niece who was orphaned and living with him from the age of 14.

His wife was sentenced to 10 years rigorous imprisonment for abetting the crime. According to the prosecution, after the death of her parents, the child had been living with her paternal uncle and his wife, who lived nearby.

Unable to bear the trauma, the girl, who tried to end her life when she was 17, was rescued by a relative. She lodged a complaint with All-Women Police (Teynampet).

The accused was arrested on Sept. 9, 2017 and remanded to judicial custody.

At the conclusion of trial, Special Judge M. Rajalakshmi held both the husband and wife guilty for offences that they were charged with.

Convicting them, the judge sentenced the man to life imprisonment. The court also directed a payment of Rs. 7 lakhs as compensation to the victim.

Chennai Metro to plant 25,000 saplings
