Last year, it launched PikBig Fashion Truck, a mobile clothing store.

"If shopping is what makes you happy but going to stores is a hectic job, this Boutique on Wheels will make your shopping experience much easier", said KarthickGunabalan (MD).

"I conceptualized the PikBig Fashion Truck, which is aimed at providing apparel at the customer's doorstep", he said.

After looking at the e-commerce craze in India and his love for fashion, he wanted to start new ways of shopping for customers.

Then emerged the idea of the boutique on wheels.

"The idea cropped up from the agriculture business in my hometown for which we have a nursery garden. The small vendors purchase plants from us and sell them on bicycles and make decent money. The transition of this journey took place from a bicycle to a four-wheeler truck," Karthick said. Air quality dips due to bursting of crackers on Karthigai Deepam

As the residents burst crackers during celebration of Karthigai Deepam, air quality in the city worsened at night on Dec. 6.

According to data from Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), the air quality index (AQI) at 8.p.m on Dec. 6 was 311 in Alandur, 258 in Perungudi, 237 in Ennore, 223 in Royapuram and 183 in Arumbakkam. The AQI was below 130 in the above areas at 8 p.m the previous day.

The air quality the next morning remained almost the same due to foggy conditions.

The AQI during Deepavali crossed 500 in several parts of the city.

Frequent technical glitches in metro ticketing

With a steady spike in passenger footfall at all Metro stations, commuters have urged Chennai Metro to rectify the frequent technical glitches faced in ticketing system and scanning.

Passengers have also alleged that a few parking lots of the stations only allow cash payment and do not have online payment facilities.

"Though these technical glitches are quickly resolved, these issues often come up. With high passenger flow, even during non-peak hours, maintenance should be top priority", said a frequent traveler from K.K. Nagar. "I recently had multiple instances where the ticket bought at the counter failed to scan, thus forcing me to seek the assistance of employees. Such minor inconveniences and repeated incidents can irritate passengers," he said. G.Devibala, a media professional working in Ashok Nagar, said that the ticketing machines installed in Ashok Nagar metro station do not work most of the time.

Phase 2 infra to operate metro trains every 90 seconds

Chennai Metro, which is on an expansion spree, on Dec. 6 announced the awarding of a high-tech tender to speed up operations and also explore the option of automatic driverless trains.

For the phase II construction, it has awarded the tender for design, manufacture, supply, installation, testing, train control, video management system and commissioning of signalling to Hitachi Rail STS SPA and Hitachi Rail STS India at the cost of Rs 1,620 crores.

The phase II metro trains are set to operate with a minimum headway of 90 seconds, a notable improvement from the existing one.

Besides the driverless/automatic operation, the system will unify with the functions of automatic train movement in the depot, operation of platform screen doors, functioning of passenger information and display system.

The safety measures of the robust system will be certified by an independent safety assessment team as per international standards.

Additionally, due to the driverless operation, the system is also set to undergo intensive testing for safety parameters.

The final approval and implementation of the system for public use will be done by the Commissioner of Metro Railway

Safety (CMRS), the statement added.

This system will ensure the real time streaming of video for monitoring, control and management from a centralised Operation Control Centre.

Tribute to late Aaroor Dass - Thiruvaroor Ther to Tenaliraman Trolley

My grandfather S. Yesudas, popularly known as Aaroor Dass (born and brought up in Thiruvaroor District), was a protégé of former Chief Minister late Kalaingar Karunanidhi and a renowned script writer in Tamil movies.

He had passed away on Nov. 20.

He and Kalaingar were school mates and possessed impressive writing skills, especially script writing from their formative days.

In later years, he followed in the footsteps of Kalaingar and specialised in dialogue writing.

He had penned story, screenplay and dialogues for nearly 1000 films.

It was actually his dialogue writing skills that bought him fame and glory.

He had penned dialogues in scores of movies of MGR, Sivaji Ganesan and other lead actors.

Several of his dialogues became infamous like the dialogues in films 'Thai Sollai Thattathay', 'Thayey Kaatha Thanayen', 'Vettaikaran', 'Pasamalar', 'Par Magale Par', 'Padithal Mattum Poduma' and 'Anbe Vaa' to name a few.

He was adept at writing romantic as well as sentimental dialogues that gave a different shade to MGR, Sivaji Ganesan and other lead actors during the same time period.

The first film for which he wrote dialogues was the Gemini Ganesan starrer 'Vazha Vaitha Dheivam'. It was Gemini Ganesan who actually introduced Doss to Sivaji.

He had worked with ace film makers like AVM, Sandow Chinnappa Thevar and also with most popular directors of that time like Thirulokachander and Bhim Singh.

He later ventured into writing dialogues for dubbed films and set a benchmark for the lip/dialogue sync as if the movies were not dubbed but shot in Tamil. Most of the movies for which he wrote the dubbing dialogues were big hits like 'Vaijyanthi IPS', 'Idhu Thanda Police' and 'Poovukul Pooghambam'. The Tamil words he selected to replace Telugu words in those films gave perfect sync for the audience.

The last film that he wrote dialogues for was the Vadivelu starrer 'Tenaliraman'.

He had also written Tamil novels and several Tamil books on various topics including Thirukkural.

He was recently felicitated by Chief Minister M. K. Stalin for his excellence in the field of script writing.

He had received several awards including Kalaimamani, Kalaivithagar and Arignar Anna Award from Tamilnadu Government and a Honourable Doctorate for his film work.

Though he is no more, his immense contribution to Tamil cinema will remain for time immemorial.

Metrowater to improve sewer infrastructure on Anna Main Road

In an effort to ensure permanent solution to the problem of subsidence, Metrowater has started preliminary work to improve the sewer infrastructure on Anna Main Road.

The Rs. 31.53-crore work is crucial as big pipelines on Anna Main Road carry nearly 80 million liters of sewage daily and even up to 118 mld during rainy days.

Sewage generated from CIT Nagar, Ashok Nagar, K.K. Nagar, MGR Nagar, Saidapet, Jaffarkhanpet and Virugambakkam is transmitted through the deep sewer lines.

Residents of MGR Nagar and K.K. Nagar said the ride on the arterial road linking areas like Nesapakkam and Ramapuram has been bumpy as a portion of it is mostly barricaded to repair portions of the road that had caved in because of sewer pipeline collapse. The water agency recently completed temporary



work to fix pipelines after a portion of the road caved in near MGR Nagar Road junction and also near Nesapakkam pumping station. Metrowater officials said the old RCC pipelines were being replaced with cast iron pipes that have a lifespan of 50 years. Instead of lines that allow flow through gravity, a system to

regulate through pressure

would be adopted to prevent spillover or bursts. These lines are laid at a depth of 5 meters to 9 meters. "We have started work to improve sewage pumping stations in Ashok Nagar and Old Nesapakkam. Similar work will be taken up in K.K. Nagar and Bharathidasan Colony pumping

stations," an official said.

Metrowater plans to start laying new pipelines linking sewage pumping stations for a distance of 3 km on Anna Main Road and Kamarajar Salai junction by mid-January. "We have sought permission for road cuts after the monsoon. Work will be over in 18 months," the official added.

Students conduct awareness rally on air pollution

About 300 National Green Corps (NGC) students from 5 schools in T. Nagar conducted a rally and formed a human chain to create awareness on air pollution in Sarada Vidyalaya Higher Secondary School (Burkit Road, T. Nagar) on Dec. 6.

The schools that participated were Sarada Vidyalaya, Asamsan Higher Secondary School, Kesari Higher Secondary School, Karnataka Sangha Higher Secondary School and MCN Higher Secondary School. The students took a pledge and formed a human chain holding placards. G. Thangaraj and Ravikumar (NGC Co-coordinators, Chennai District), K. Rama (Headmistress, RKM Sarada School), P. Lalitha (NGC Coordinator), traffic police personnel and teachers were present.



Construction sites fined over mosquito breeding

In a bid to reduce mosquito breeding, Chennai Corporation on Dec. 3 carried out a mosquito eradication drive.

A total fine of Rs 51,000 was imposed on 45 construction sites found to be hotspots for mosquito breeding.

In addition, several works like spraying of pesticides and larvicides are being done to control mosquito breeding in all 15 zones.

Corporation field workers inspected vacant plots, open wells, construction sites, and storage tanks in the city. There are 3,189 construction sites, of which 45 were found to produce mosquito larvae.

Mosquito control works are being carried out, especially in slum areas with 229 hand-operated fumigating machines, 8 small fumigating machines, and 67 vehicle-mounted fumigating machines.

During the field survey, 3,596 kg of tyres, and 5,200 kg of mosquito breeding potential was found in 2,919 places in the city. The concerned owners were fined. If there are waste tyres, coconut shells, broken jugs, and broken cement tanks in their houses and surroundings, there is a possibility of mosquitoes breeding in water. They should be removed immediately to prevent the spread of diseases, including dengue.

Work orders issued for South Usman Road flyover

Work on two major projects in the city, the flyover on South Usman Road (T. Nagar) and the rail overbridge over Ganesapuram subway (Thiru Vi Ka Nagar) is to start soon.

According to a senior official, Chennai Corporation has issued work orders for construction of the flyovers.

He said test piling is being undertaken in the two bridges.

The flyover to be constructed on South Usman Road will be two-laned and is expected to clear the congestion on the stretch by connecting the junction near T. Nagar bus terminus and will extend upto CIT Nagar, stopping around 100 meters short of Anna Salai.

"The project will be carried out at an estimated cost of Rs. 98.63 crores and will be completed in two years," a senior corporation official said.

Considering this is one of the busiest stretches in the city and a commercial hub, officials are expecting a disruption in traffic as work progresses.

While alternative routes have not been finalised, officials said that they are working out the details to ensure minimal disruption.

He had ridden the bike extensively around his hometown Alwar for a months and completed the first service before starting.


He rested every 300 km and avoided riding after sunset.

Based on those forged documents, the accused executed sale deeds in favour of four persons, said the police.

The police have launched a search to nab four more accused in the case.

Chennai Corporation has drawn up plans to install 9,144 street lights in Madhavaram, T. Nagar, Teynampet, Kodambakkam, Kolathur, Nungambakkam and Adyar areas.

Earlier this year, the Corporation had identified 38 neighbourhoods in the city that were facing the problem of poor illumination and announced that facilities would be added under the Nirbhaya Fund to improve the safety of women.

"Keeping in mind the safety of women and children, LED lights are being installed for better illumination in locations identified as dark spots by the Corporation and the police in both core city areas and extended zone areas", said an official.

As better lighting will improve camera surveillance, the new street lamp-posts with LED lights are being installed, an official said.

So far, 4,944 lamp-posts have been erected and 1,194 LED lights energized, he said.

70 sovereigns of jewelsburgled from house in West Mambalam

Police are searching for an unidentified gang that broke into the house of a techie in West Mambalam night on Nov. 28 and decamped with more than 70 sovereigns of jewellery.

The house was locked since Nov. 25 as the owner Surya Narayanan, who works in an IT company, was away with his family on a vacation.

When the domestic servant came to the house on Nov. 29, she saw the front door lock broken and alerted the house owner.

Following a complaint, Ashok Nagar police visited the house.

Preliminary investigation revealed that about 70 sovereigns of jewellery and other valuable articles were stolen from the house.

Police have taken fingerprints from the scene and are also perusing CCTV footage from the neighbourhood to ascertain the identity of the suspects.

Work orders issued for South Usman Road flyover

Work on two major projects in the city, the flyover on South Usman Road (T. Nagar) and the rail overbridge over Ganesapuram subway (Thiru Vi Ka Nagar) is to start soon.

According to a senior official, Chennai Corporation has issued work orders for construction of the flyovers.

He said test piling is being undertaken in the two bridges.

The flyover to be constructed on South Usman Road will be two-laned and is expected to clear the congestion on the stretch by connecting the junction near T. Nagar bus terminus and will extend upto CIT Nagar, stopping around 100 meters short of Anna Salai.

"The project will be carried out at an estimated cost of Rs. 98.63 crores and will be completed in two years," a senior corporation official said.

Considering this is one of the busiest stretches in the city and a commercial hub, officials are expecting a disruption in traffic as work progresses.

While alternative routes have not been finalised, officials said that they are working out the details to ensure minimal disruption.

Corporation to use drones to tackle mosquito menace

Chennai Corporation is preparing to transition from fogging to drone operations to tackle the mosquito problem.

Corporation officials said the civic body is gearing up to switch to full-fledged drone operations in January and residents will be able to notice a difference almost immediately.

The mosquitoes have increased in T. Nagar, Adyar, Velachery, Sowcarpet, Vyasarpadi and other places.

T. Nagar residents complained that fogging is not regular. They said following the rains, mosquitoes are increasing as there are several open drains filled with stagnant water owing to the incomplete storm water drainworks in several places.

"Our first area of focus will be waterbodies. Once that is done, we will carry out drone operations in storm water drains. We will also map which storm water drains carry water throughout the year, especially during April-May when there is no rain, to spot illegal sewage connections," said a Corporation officer.

Drones were employed twice before as pilots, and officials said they recorded around 95% efficiency.
