



Govinda Govinda Govinda

Twelve of us were close friends since school and college, and, during our younger care-free days, could always be seen together.

We used to go to Tiruppathi on December 31 every year. Our new year would always start at the Balaji temple on Thirumalai hill.

After staying at Thirupathi overnight, we would have our breakfast at Balaji Bhavan and start climbing the hill early in the morning, singing and dancing. With all such fun, we would not feel any difficulty in climbing the steps.

In one such year, our entire gang of 12 left Chennai together and reached Tiruppathi at around 10.30 at night.

Unfortunately we could not get any accommodation there for staying overnight. We tried at hotels, cottages and the Travellers Bungalow but without success.

There used to be a school where pilgrims were allowed to stay overnight, but permission was denied to us even there on that night.

Not knowing what to do, we were walking along the TTD cottages.

There was one Ram Singh, a Sardar, in our group. His father ran a motor car spare parts shop on General Patters Road. He was quite fluent in Tamil.

He said, "Dey Ramu, your Govinda has left us in the lurch today".

I replied, "No, Ram Singh. Govinda will never abandon his devotees, and will always rush to our help even from a distance of thousand miles".

Saying this, I shouted aloud, "Govinda, Govinda, Govinda".

It was pitch dark in December night and one could not recognise even nearby faces.

Two persons were walking ahead of us and one of them, on hearing my voice, asked, "Is it Ramu? Madras Ramu?".

I said, "Yes, I am Ramu. Who are you?"

"Don't you recognise me? This is Mukundan of Meteorological Department".

Mukundan was my college friend though we had not seen each other in the past few years, and we got closer.

He asked me, "Why are you loitering like this in this cold night?"

I explained to him our plight. "We are twelve of us and have been searching for accommodation for the night".

He said, "Don't worry. I and my friend here have booked two cottages in the TTD complexes, and we can all share them. You can bring all your luggage".

With profuse thanks to Mukundan we shared the two cottages for the night.

I told Ram Singh, "Are you now convinced that Govinda will come to our help if we call him with faith?".

He did not believe what I said. "It is by fluke that your friend was walking ahead of us today", he said.

Next morning we climbed the hill, did angapradakshanam and had good darshan of Balaji after standing in a long queue.

We were very hungry when we returned to our cottage by noon.

I told Ram Singh, "I shouted 'Govinda' last night and He helped us get accommodation. Let us all shout 'Govinda' now, and He will help us get some food".

Ram Singh was not convinced but yet we all shouted in unison 'Govinda, Govinda, Govinda'.

Believe it or not, a young man emerged from the next cottage and said in Telugu, "I am from Ongole. I have a lot of temple prasaadham left. Will you please join me in eating it?".

Ram Singh asked me what he was saying.

I told him that he was requesting us to take our share of the temple prasaadham.

In fact there was enough and more of the prasaadham for all twelve of us, and we ate it all to our heart's content.

I told Ram Singh, "See, Govinda is always present within our call's distance. Did he not respond to the call of Gajendran and Draupadi? What is needed is your faith that he will come to your aid when needed".

I do not know if Ram Singh was fully convinced. So far I am concerned, Govinda has always responded to my prayers.

The 'Thevaaram Hymn'

I knew Justice Suryamurthy well, and have pleasure in quoting him in his own words:

"At the age of 15 or 16, I was a rank atheist. Our family had a coconut farm in our village and a Muslim family was living there and looking after it. The head of that family was reputed for curing snake bites, and persons from the neighbourhood who could not find cure from hospitals would come to him as a last resort. He would place some neem leaves on the victim's head, chant a few lines of some verse and the victim would be rid of the snake's venom without any further medication and return home in good health.

I was witness to such cure many times and asked him what it was that he chanted which resulted in the cure for snake bite.

He refused saying, "I cannot reveal my mantra to an atheist like you. If ever you develop faith in God, you come to me and I will tell you then".

Years rolled, I studied law and had become a judge in Pondicherry. In the meantime, I had ceased to be an atheist and developed great faith in Saivism and became well conversant with Saivite literature.

One day I remembered the Muslim gentleman and went to my village, met him and, telling him of my transformation, asked him if he would tell me the mantra at least now.


He said, "You come to me after a bath and I will tell you".

When, thereafter, he chanted the hymn in my ears, I was surprised to recognise that what he chanted was nothing but a Thevaaram hymn sung by Saint Thirunaavukkarasar to raise the son of Appoodhi Adigal when the boy had died of snake bite.

When I told him that it was a Saivite hymn, he said, "I do not know what it is. This was what my teacher taught me and I repeat it to cure my patients".

It was then that I realised that Thevaaram is a Tamil Vedham and each of its hymns is a mantra which would bring benefit if chanted with faith even by a person of another religion who does not know what it is and what it means".

Trial runs on Vadapalani-Poonamallee metro stretch to start soon

With the track works nearing completion, Chennai Metro aims to start trial runs on the 6-km stretch from Vadapalani to Poonamallee depot in its Phase II project from mid-Jan.

A senior official said that nearly 4,000 workers have been deployed along the corridor to accelerate the work on the double-decker metro corridor.

He said that about 3,000 workers are engaged in viaduct and deck slab construction, 600 in track-laying, and the remaining 400 in traction and signalling works as commercial operations are being targeted for end-January or early February. To meet the deadline, 57 cranes have been pressed into service.

Chennai Metro had originally planned to open the first Phase II section of 9.5-km on the Poonamallee-Porur stretch in December, but that plan got delayed due to certification issues.


The CCTV network was inaugurated on Dec. 31.

Corporation to implement city-wide smart parking system
