

### Dr. Rangabashyam - An Embodiment of Nobility

On 15th July, 2013, I was deeply saddened when I received information that Dr. Rangabashyam, the great surgeon, had passed away peacefully at his residence.

He was an authority in Gastroenterology both in India and abroad and was a holder of FRCS from England. He had been awarded Padma Bhushan by Government of India.

To know him closely was my great privilege.

He was referred to me by a good friend of mine when he faced a legal problem. The doctor's brother-in-law's daughter had been married to a cine star. It was later alleged that the girl was already married to some person while she was studying in college. It was a registered marriage though the two never lived together. After she had finished college, the registered marriage was forgotten by both spouses and the parents of the girl arranged her traditional marriage with the film star.

The actor was upset when he came to know about the earlier marriage of his wife. A criminal complaint was filed by him that he had been a victim of cheating and suppression of material information. What was shocking was that Dr. Rangabashyam was included as an accused in the complaint alleging that he had accompanied the bride's family for buying wedding sarees. On the basis of this allegation, Dr. Rangabashyam's name was included in the FIR.

Dr. Rangabashyam got in touch with me about this case. Bail was granted to him on condition that he should sign in the police station periodically. I felt there was a good case for getting the case against him quashed *ab initio*. Being a civil lawyer not fully conversant with the criminal side, I consulted some giants on the criminal side. All of them felt that the doctor had a good case for acquittal but it was not possible to get an order of quashing the charge *ab initio* and that he had to undergo the ordeal of trial which could extend to a couple of years. But I was not happy as I genuinely felt that the High Court, if properly approached, would quash the charges against the doctor.


I discussed the matter with my young friend Amizhdu who was coming up very well in the criminal side, and we decided to file a petition for quashing. The petition came up for hearing before Justice Jeyapaul who, after hearing the arguments for just 20 minutes, passed orders quashing the criminal proceedings against the doctor.

I was confirmed in my belief that Allopathy may fail, Homeopathy may fail but Venkatachalam shall never fail.

Dr. Rangabashyam was very happy at the result. It is needless to say I was even more happy to get such an order from the High Court to reaffirm my faith in the Goddess of Justice.

During my periodical meetings with the doctor, I found him to be a man of exceptional simplicity, ability and nobility, not only in the medical field but also in various other fields. More than a doctor, he was very humane in his approach and outlook.

One day, in a meeting at my office, I casually mentioned to him that I had some digestion problem and that I would like to consult him in his clinic. A tall man of more than 6 feet, he immediately pushed his chair behind, stood up, went near the door, bolted it and asked me to lie on my office table itself. I was taken aback by the spontaneous gesture of this genius and said "Nothing doing doctor, I respect you and your profession and I shall come tomorrow to your clinic". But he refused and examined me on my office table itself and gave his medical advice. What a humane person he was!



I must narrate one more incident about him which he shared with me.

Around 1990, when he was living in England, there was an international conference of doctors. He had invited a doctor from France for tea one day. While he and the guest doctor were having tea, an old lady passed through the hall. On seeing her, the guest doctor asked Dr. Rangabashyam whether he had brought a cook from India..

Dr. Rangabashyam said that the lady was his mother.

The guest doctor asked Dr. Rangabashyam, "Did your wife agree to your mother staying with you?".

Dr. Rangabashyam replied, "My wife's consent is irrelevant. My mother had brought me to this world and today I am with you because of her. So she will stay with me as long as she lives. Incidentally my wife is being treated by my mother like her daughter and my wife is also very happy".

Three years later there was a conference in France, and Dr. Rangabashyam was invited by the same doctor to his house. When Dr. Rangabashyam was about to leave after tea, the host doctor told him, "Can you guess who is living in the outhouse now? It is my mother. Every morning I visit her before going to the hospital, have a cup of coffee and spend about 10 minutes with her. Similarly, on return in the evening, I again visit her when she would be waiting for me with tea and biscuits. This gives both of us immense pleasure. I learnt the practice from you".

When I heard this, I told Dr. Rangabashyam, "You did India proud, doctor!"

Around 2009, while in Singapore, his wife was admitted for surgery in a hospital. Dr. Rangabashyam was patiently waiting in the lobby when, at about 12 midnight, one of the doctors came out of the operation theatre and told him to go to the room and relax.

Dr. Rangabashyam told him, "Rain or shine, my wife has been with me for the past 55 years. Now, when she is critically ill, should I not be here and pray to God to bless her for a speedy recovery. Is it not my duty?". The Singapore doctor was spell bound!

I am sad that such a great man is no longer with us. I can only pray, "Oh God! You have taken away Dr. Rangabashyam. Please send one of your representatives again to us!"

### Licence, microchipping must for cattle



Chennai Corporation on Jan. 30 passed a council resolution mandating cattle owners to obtain licences and microchip their cattle.

The move is part of measures to regulate cattle rearing and curb the stray cattle problem in the city.

Cattle owners have been asked to submit their licence applications on or before March 18, with the licence fee fixed at Rs 100 per cattle head.

The application forms can be downloaded from the Corporation's website and submitted to the zonal veterinary officers in the respective zones.

Veterinary officials will then conduct field inspections before issuing licences. At the time of licensing, microchips will be implanted in each cattle to digitally record ownership details, including the owner's name, address, and the cattle's details.

An official said that Corporation has procured 25,000 microchips and 25 microchip readers.

Yajur Veda Gana Paaraayanam, Kamya homam, Sadha Chandi homam and discourses will take place in the mornings and evenings.



### 'பூசமுன் யோசி!'

அன்றாட வாழ்வில் நாம் பயன்படுத்தும் சில பொருட்கள் நம் தோலில் சில வகைக் கரப்பான்களை (Eczema) ஏற்படுத்தும்.

தோலின் மீது அவை படுவதால் நேரடியாகவோ அல்லது ஒரு வகை அலர்ஜியினாலோ ஏற்படுத்தும் கரப்பான்களுக்கு 'தொடு பொருள் கரப்பான்' (Contact dermatitis) என்று பெயர்.

இரண்டு வகையான காண்டாக்ட் டெர்மடைடில் உள்ளன. (1) தொடும் பொருள் நேரடியாகத் தோலில் மாற்றங்களை ஏற்படுத்தும் 'இரிடன்ட் காண்டாக்ட் டெர்மடைடில்' (சுடிநீர், அமிலம்). (2) தொடும் பொருள் இரத்தத்தில் கலந்து, உடலின் டிலிம்போசேட்டில் செல்கள் மூலம் அப்பொருளுக்கு எதிரான ஓர் ஆண்டிபாடியை உண்டாக்கி அதன் மூலம் அவற்றை வெளியேற்ற முயற்சிக்கும் 'இம்பியூன் ரியாக்ஷன்'. தோலில் வரும் 'அலர்ஜிக் காண்டாக்ட் டெர்மடைடில்' (பூசம் சில மருந்துகள், பார்த்தீனியன் செடி).

உடலின் எந்தெந்த இடங்களில் கரப்பான் வந்துள்ளது என்பது முக்கியமானது. கைகடிகாரம் கட்டும் இடத்தில் மட்டும் கரப்பான் வந்திருந்தால், காரணம் உள்ளங்கை நெல்லிக்கனி போல்: மணிக்கட்டில் கடிகாரம்! கடிகாரப் பட்டையோ அல்லது உலோகப் பகுதியோ காரணமாக இருக்கலாம். கழுத்தில் அணியும் ஆபரணம் முதல் காலில் அணியும் செருப்பு வரை எதுவும் அலர்ஜியாகவோ இரிட்டன்ட் டெர்மடைடில் ஓரளவுக்கு எளிதில் தெரிந்து விடும். அனால் ஆலர்ஜிக் டெர்மடைடில் கண்டுபிடிக்க நேரமும், பொறுமையும் வேண்டும்; நீண்ட நேர தகவல் சேகரிப்பு மட்டுமே உதவும். அலர்ஜியாவும் வரும் கரப்பான்களில் முதலில் மெல்லிய தோல் உள்ள கண்டுபிடிக்க வேண்டும்; பின்னர் உடல் முழுவதும் வந்து விடும். இதற்கு என்னால் வந்தது என்பதைக் கண்டறிய செய்யப்படும் 'பேட்ச் டெஸ்ட்' (Patch test) முக்கியமான ஒன்று!

இப்போது இந்தப் பெண்ணின் கதையைக் கேளுங்கள்!

உள்ளே வந்த நங்கைக்கு இருபத்தெந்து வயதிருக்கும். முகம் 'பளிச்'சென்று, வில்லிய புருவத்துறைம், சிவப்பு உட்டடுச் சாயத்துறைம், நூறு வாட்டஸ் பல்பைப் போல் பிரகாசமா யிருந்தது. தேய்க்கப்பட்ட வெள்ளித் துண்டுகளும், தக்காளி வட்டங்களும் பூசப்பட்ட கிபேஸ் பேர்க்குளும் அப்பெண்ணின் முகத்துக்கு ஒரு செயற்கையான அழகைத் தந்து கொண்டிருந்தன.

சிறிது தயங்கியவாரே, 'காலில் கொஞ்சம் ஸ்கின் ரியாக்ஷன் ஆயிடிச்சு' என்றாள்.

ராமர் கலரில் மஞ்சள் தேய்த்த மாதிரி ஒரு 'நீஞ்சன் (நீலம்+மஞ்சன்) நிறத்தில் இருந்தது கணுக்கால்! ஆங்காங்கே சிவப்பும், வெளிர் மஞ்சங்குமாய் ரத்தம், சீம்புவுளிகள். நகத்தினாலேயோ, சீப்பினாலேயோ கீரிய மெருள் வரிகள்; காய்ந்த பொருக்குள்ள; வடியும் நீருடன் சிறிது வீக்கமான கணுக்கால்! முகத்தைப் பார்த்தேன், ஃபியூஸ் போன பல்புபோல் ஒனியிழுந்திருந்து.




